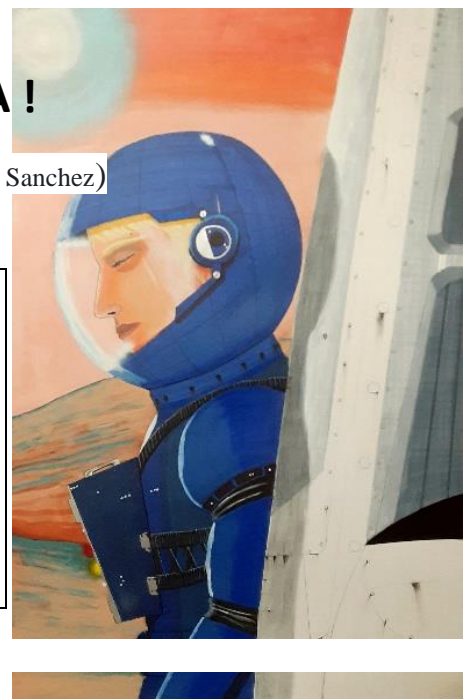

# Star Trek vs. Star Trek vs. Star Trek – Part VII: vs. STAR WARS

So, .... Star Trek franchise vs Star Wars franchise – which is better?

Hmm...this seems to be a dilemma for most fans of either universe. Before I set down my own opinion, I decided to see what others think. After breezing through a few articles, I selected 3 that show various perspectives on the issue in question. As pointed out in article#3 by Dylan Roth, what seemed apparent in the early years of each franchise has slowly faded away or changed – in **some ways**, and sometimes in **many ways** – there seems to be a steady convergence of genres even though they are still unique universes.

Before you get to article #3 (the reason I numbered them) I recommend you take a quick look at the other two articles:

Article #1 – a bit simplistic – (if only because I suspect that either a poor writer or an AI app prepared it 😊) – of course, you are welcome to skip it too. It is a very, very general overview of the two franchises, and seems to make some strange presumptions.

Article #2 is worth looking at, particularly since it has accompanying related videos. It also contains a 2-column comparison chart with numerous characteristics presented.

### **AND NOW – my take ‘Science’ vs. ‘Fiction’:**

What always fascinated me in Star Trek was the problem-solving aspect. It is more often than not an intellectual exercise on how to get out of a situation, or how to best involve oneself, without possibly causing turmoil for others – using the “Prime Directive” as a kind of litmus testing device. The fun parts – other than the fisticuffs of TOS, or the moral/ethical dilemmas touched on in TNG – include how far the rules can be bent (and in which way), by the various captains and crew members. Star Trek – is what we could call ‘hard core’ SF, with many pure Science issues handled in the episodes, in addition to ethical and social issues.

Star Wars, on the other hand, is mostly swashbuckling fun, with a lot of political agenda and various black-and-white moral issues: The good guys vs. the bad guys. Simple (or simpler than Star Trek) – and enjoyable without me needing to rack my brain – how would I have reacted, or what would I have done, given a particular situation. – Epic fiction.

I enjoy both, with more weight given the Star Trek episodes – because I like a good problem that needs a solution. I enjoy Star Wars for relaxing, letting the mind wander and enjoying the action and exotic landscapes and settings.



## #1: Which is Better, Star Wars or Star Trek? by 1883

In the world of science fiction, two entities rule the roost Star Wars and Star Trek. Both are science-based and involve spaceships and aliens.

**Star Trek**, originally a TV series, is a space western science fiction that centers around a crew who serves in *Starfleet*, a space-based peacekeeping and humanitarian armada. **Star Wars**, originally a trilogy, is a space opera fantasy franchise set in the distant past of a fictional galaxy, revolving around princes, princesses, knighthood, and chivalry. Both these highly popular and successful franchises are now being revived with new movies directed by J.J. Abrams.

Until the recent movies, *Star Trek* has been more of a cult phenomena than *Star Wars*, and therefore did not have the same level of mainstream fandom and cultural influence. *Star Wars* is grander in scope and has a complex web of political agendas, alien species, personal feuds, and galaxy-wide domination. The *Star Trek* world is modern, sleek, and shiny, while some of *Star Wars*' settings are dirty and grimy.
