RUSTY HEVELIN WINS DUFF!

Rusty Hevelin received 110 votes of the 212 ballots cast, and so will be making the trip to Aussiecon as DUFF representative. John Berry came in second with 72 votes, and Jan Howard Finder received 30 votes. The winner was thus decided on the first ballot.

183 ballots were received by the American administrator, and votes were distributed as follows; Hevelin -- 105, Berry -- 55, finder -- 23. 29 ballots were received by the Australian administrator. Rusty Hevelin got 5 of those votes, John Berry got 17 and Jan Finder got 7. 154 ballots were from the USA, 27 from Australia, 12 from Italy, 11 from Canada, 3 from U.K., 2 from Germany and 1 each from Holland, France and Belgium.

MONEY

At present there is a total of \$1448.51 in the US DUFF account. The large increase since the last newsletter is due in part to a \$200 donation from Confusion, \$100 from Discon, \$10 from the NSF, and auctions at Doskone and Minicon. The breakdown of total monies received by the American administrator so far in this DUFF race: \$157.37 carried over from last year's fund, \$437.13 donations received with ballots, \$522.90 other contributions and \$331.11 from auctions, sale of fanzines, interest on the account, etc.

The Australian administrator had \$174.67 on hand at last report, including \$11.67 carry-over funds, \$29.00 donations with ballots, \$33.50 other contributions and \$45.30 from other sources. This means DUFF currently has on hand close to \$1700 US, more than enough to pay for Rusty Hevelin's trip. Thanks again to all DUFF contributors for making this year's race a success.
