(Minutes)

The meeting was called to order at 1:40 p.m. by President Bob Hyde, following a luncheon.

Application blanks were offered for the use of those present who might like to join or know of someone who may like to join.

A letter from Rev. Heins was mentioned; also word from Dale Walker.

Vern Coriell, Editor and Founder of the Burroughs Bibliophiles, was introduced. He displayed the publications that had been mailed to members in the two years since the club was organized.

Coriell stated that he was going to try to mail publications every two months and the Burroughs Bulletin twice a year; also, very soon he would mail a story by Bill Gilmour entitled "Tarzan and the Lightning Man."

President Hyde introduced other ERB fanzine editors who were present, Pete Ogden and Caz Gazedessus.

The meeting was turned over to Al Howard, who made a presentation of a silver bowl carrying the inscription, "To Mrs. J. Allen St. John from the Burroughs Bibliophiles, September 2, 1962." Mrs. St. John accepted the gift and spoke a few words, recalling some interesting instances in the life of J. Allen St. John.

Rather than have a formal meeting, it was decided to have a general discussion. The floor was thrown open to any member wishing to ask a question. The following questions were asked:

Q: When are future meetings scheduled?
A: Indefinite. Washington, D. C. received the vote for the next Science Fiction convention in 1963. No doubt we will have ours again with the Science Fiction group. The Burroughs meeting in Cincinnati was so disappointing, President Hyde said he felt that if the club did not have a good turn-out at the Chicago meeting, it never would. He commented that there had been a good turn-out, so we would continue to hold meetings at the Science Fiction conventions.

Q: When are we going to have an election of officers? Why not at this meeting?

A: We do not have enough members attending this luncheon to represent the majority of members. The problem is is not in holding an election, but in finding people who are willing to run for office and do the work involved.

Q: Why is there not a better means of communication between the members. A list or something should be given the members so that they may communicate with each other.

A: A roster is going to be published and mailed to each member, listing all members in good standing. This roster will be attached to a Dum-Dum which will also carry the Treasurer's report and the Minutes of the Meeting. With this roster, all members may feel free to distribute any material they wish to reach other members.

Q: Why is there not an ERB fanzine list published?

A: There was a list published in Gridley Wave #5.

Q: Would it be a good idea for someone to publish a collectors' list in some form of cheaply printed magazine, listing all material that is available to read, sell or buy?

A: Our club does not want to go into business and that need is being filled already by Fantasy Collector.

Q: Do you think it would be a good idea to encourage members in certain areas to correspond and meet among themselves?

A: That is a very good idea. Some clubs have members who meet and create regional clubs, even to electing regional officers. The Minutes of the regional meetings could be submitted to Vern Coriell for possible publication in the Dum-Dum. It would be impossible, though, for the National Officers to attend meetings of such groups.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:15 p.m. and the members were invited to remain for a social get-together and visit.

The Prez Sez

I was very pleased, and perhaps somewhat surprised, by the turn-out of 55 members and guests for our luncheon meeting. I didn't have half that number by the deadline I had set of August 22nd. However, the hotel was very cooperative, and even set up another table of eight for us, as late as the time to start serving the meal.

Stanleigh Vinson deserves much thanks in his selection of the silver bowl for Mrs. J. Allen St. John, our guest of honor. This was a gift from the club in appreciation of St. John's unsurpassed visualization of the Burroughs characters.

Allan Howard, with a short but very appropriate speech made the presentation to Mrs. St. John. I think all of us enjoyed Mrs. St. John's acceptance remarks, reminding of days gone by when Mr. Burroughs would visit the studio. A very gracious lady, and we were honored to have her as our guest.

I have been tabulating some of the answers to the membership application questions with some interesting, but perhaps not too surprising, results.

QUESTION I— Are you a reader of Edgar Rice Burroughs books?

On 151 answers from a possible 173, only 10,

or 7%, answered in the negative. Most of those who answered NO said something about having read them all before. This must have looked like a trick question to many, with the implication that they would not be accepted as a member unless they answered YES. There must be many more who no longer read them. Perhaps not—just my opinion.

QUESTION II— Who is your favorite Edgar Rice Burroughs character?

Again 151 answers out of a possible 173.

With 25 titles announced for publication this year, a great majority of those requested will probably see print. If all of these 25 are published, and more next year, it will probably depend upon how the sales are for the earlier ones produced.

I was greatly surprised at the answers to these questions. I assumed that the answers would indicate those considered to be the "best" books, but it really indicates which ones each member is having a hard time finding for his collection.

Another statistic, not asked on the application, shows that we have eleven females in the club at this time, out of 184, or 6%. We may have a higher percentage, since only initials are given in some cases.

I am sorry to report that not all members contributed to the preceding tabulation. At this writing, there are still 18 members who have not completed a questionnaire, some after several requests to do so. I guess 90% should be considered good for an organization such as this. I think it should be higher.

Camille Cazedessus, living in Baton Rouge, La. and Pete Ogden, who resides in Windsor, Ontario, are both in ideal positions to assist in creating BBs chapters in their respective localities, since both publish fanzines. Such regional BB chapters would certainly have the approval of the national organization and, in fact, we are encouraging same. However, it should be understood that groups of this kind would be self-supported and their activities and publications financed through their own efforts.

Due to the fact that Robert Horvath's time is consumed in obtaining a college education, he found it impossible



to devote enough of his time to act as Secretary for the Burroughs Bibliophiles. Bob Hyde has been doing a very competent job of acting as Secretary and President for this organization, but the two jobs were too time consuming for us to expect this to be a continuing thing. You will note that we have appointed a new Secretary. Since the address of the Secretary and Editor are now the same, new members will receive prompt attention in obtaining such things as club publications, etc., as correspondence will no longer have to go through channels to reach the Editor.
