SECRETARY TREASURER'S REPORT

The Secretary Treasurer's Report is prepared by the Secretary Treasurer, Bob and Peggy Rae Pavlat, who receive and record changes of address, receive dues, keep track of activity, and try to maintain a full roster of members.

One member has complained that he can't understand the roster, and all the symbols. Only two symbols really count:

D - get your dues in to me before the next mailing deadline. (14 Feb 81).

A - meet your activity requirement within the next three months (unless the symbol is ATM, in which case activity needed must be in this current mailing).

Reading from left to right across the roster, which follows, you'll find the following data. Obviously, if something is not applicable to the member, the symbol or bit of information won't be present:

#The address for the member (or possibly his name) is different from that listed in the last FA.

A number--1, 2, etc. The member's current place on the roster. The only real reason this appears is as a control for the Secretary Treasurer, to help insure that all members have been listed--which answers a question Warner asked some years back.

Name, address, etc. I don't think I'll explain this. But if you have changed name or address and expect the ST to report that fact, then you should advise the ST of the new data. The ST types the roster a week or two before the mailing deadline; what he doesn't know by then won't be reported.

(\$x) Funds on deposit, after deducting any dues owed this mailing.

A number, often either 8 or 0. Pages you owe Fapa in order to renew your membership. Pages in this mailing have not been credited.

A month. The month of membership expiration. Both dues and activity are due before the mailing date (which is the second Saturday) of the month shown.

D - A reminder. Your dues are due before next mailing date.

A - Another reminder. You owe activity in or before the next mailing.

ATM - Activity owed is due this mailing.

AFeb, AMay, etc. Used for new members. Activity they owe is due in the mailing for the month shown (or before) rather than in their normal renewal month.

\$ - Dues are due this mailing. As of the date this is typed (the 2nd of November) they have not been received.

That covers reading the roster.

Please remember the dues increase. Dues are \$7.00 for members residing in North America, \$5.00 for oversea members.
