## GOLD TO CONTINUE AS EDITOR

### GOLD TO EDIT STF ANTHOLOGY

NEW YORK, NY, 7 September, (CNS) - It was announced today that starting with the next (October 1951) issue, Galaxy Science Fiction, will be published under a new management. While WORLD EDITIONS was French & Italian, the new management will be entirely American.

### NEXT FEW ISSUES SLIGHTLY DELAYED

Because of the new arrangements, the next few issues of Galaxy will be slightly delayed. Mr. Gold assures us that the delay will be only in the nature of a week or so, but all efforts will be made to have the issues back on original schedule (about the 8th of each month) as soon as possible. Due to the fact that the current issue was published earlier than it should, the time between it and the October issue may seem overlong. But, Mr. Gold, informed us, NO ISSUES WILL BE SKIPPED!

### IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NEAR FUTURE

Many improvements, in illustrations, in printing etc., are in the planning stage, and should show up in the very near future. Improvements that will make Galaxy the number one stf magazine, not only in text, but in appearance as well. The next three issues will show no such improvements, starting with the January 1952 issue & or shortly as possible thereafter the new improvements now being planned should show themselves. Mr. Gold is confident that under the new arrangements, the magazine will be a mile-post in the history of stf publication.

### COMING STORIES

Mr. Gold announced today that the issue following the end of the current serial "The Puppet Masters" will contain a novella, "World Without Children" by Damon Knight and that the next serial, starting in the issue after that, will be by Alfred Bester and is tentatively titled, "The Demolished Man", which from all indications should be about the best serial so far published in Galaxy.
