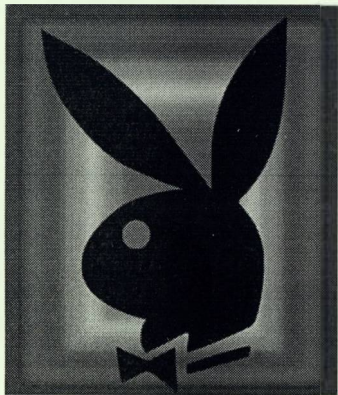

## Editorial

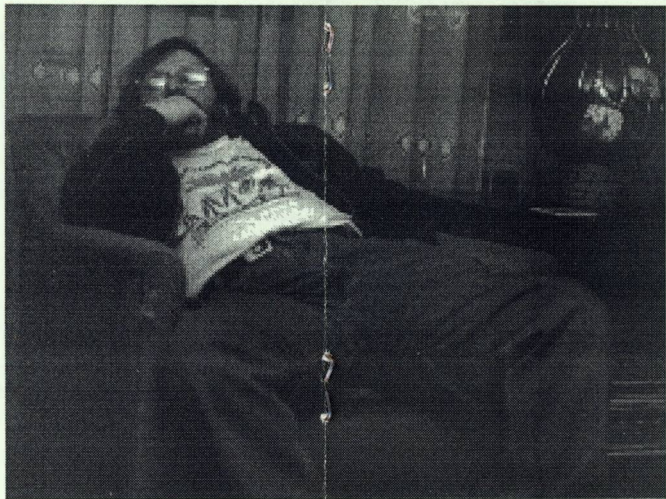
