- Treasurer- Caryl Bucklin

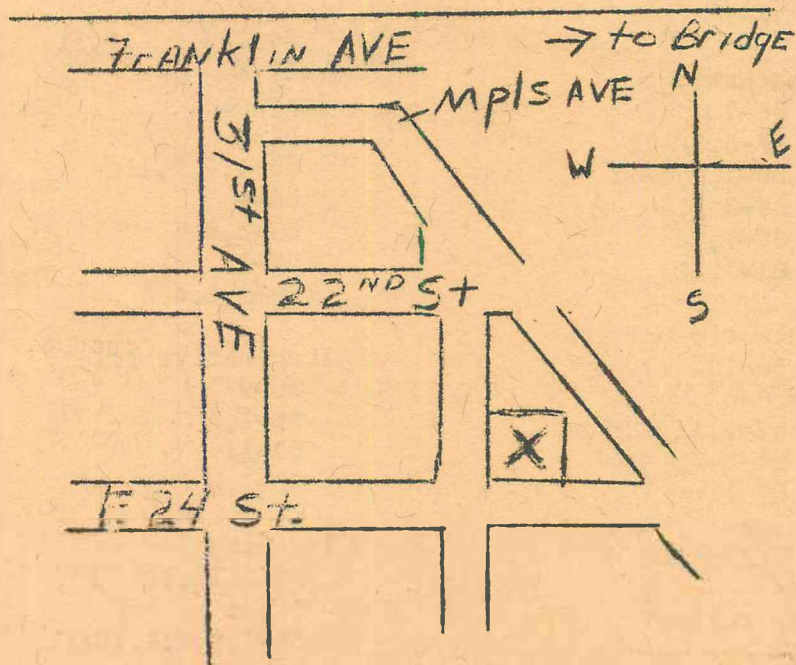

MINN-STF LIBRARY

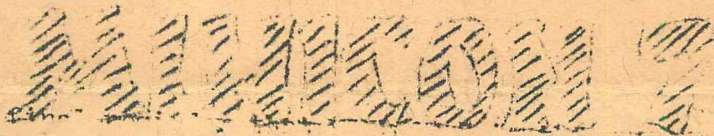
