

This will have to be a very brief issue, as the 11th hour has gone by already, and the 13th hour is on its way. But I thought I should have a couple pages to go along with the rest of the fanzine sale sheets that I over-ran from APA L.

If you order from the Fanzine Sale lists, send the order first, without the money, as quite a number of the items are sold out and it isn't worth writing back and forth trying to use up a two-bit credit. I recommend to the attention of any self-appointed Fan-Historians, the fairly good collection of Worldcon Progress Reports and Program Booklets, which is still available. Especially the Clevention ones. And there are still a lot of good zines left in spite of the lists being picked over already.

From Fanzine Sales to Fanzine Publishing. Herewith the rules and regulations for anyone wanting me to run his stencils: I can use stencils with any kind of heading -- four-hole, Gestetner, etc. -- but the typing should be equivalent to lines 2-60 on a regular legalength 4-hole stencil. No short stencils accepted; they have to be legalength (about 84 lines). Charges are 1¢ per sheet (2 pages) per copy; This makes it \$1.50 for 50 copies of a 6pp zine. One-sided sheets are 8/10¢ per sheet per copy, as you still have to use the paper. And last-minute Rush items -- zines that arrive five days or less before the mailing -- are charged an extra 20%.

...and from there to Fanzine Collecting.

I know a number of people who publish fanzines, get other fanzines and read them, and then give away or otherwise dispose of their zines. Perhaps it's for lack of room, prevalence of other interests, or simply lack of desire to collect the things at all. But the majority of fans who publish also collect fanzines, to one degree or another. These various degrees range from the guy who saves only The Best through the one who saves only APA mailings, down to the lunatic who collects everything he can get his hands on...the Completist Fanzine Collector.

As is fairly well known, I'm a completist myself. As far as I can remember, I have only thrown away one zine in the eight years or so I've been in fandom, for which I had no duplicate. [It was Margaret Gemignani's comiczine MASK & CAPE -- a dissertation on crudzines later, maybe.] My files include everything from GRUE and HYPHEN to THE SICK ELEPHANT, and they take up most of four large filing cabinets plus 120+ bound volumes. That's a lot of ~~waste paper~~ fanzines.

You characters are already in N'APA, so you have a head start on being a collector if you want to be one. You have a guaranteed influx of 150 zines a year or more, as long as you keep publishing and pay your dues. If you want to collect other APAs, you'll have to join them -- or at least get on the waiting lists, as SAPS, OMPA, and, to some extent, FAPA sell mailings to Waiting-listers. So do INTERAPA, APA 45, and SFPA. The Cult you'll have to actually become a member or Active Waiting Lister (if you don't understand what an AWLer is, consult the FANDBOOK on the subject of APAs) in order to guarantee that you'll get the magazines. I have no idea what arrangements TAPS has for this sort of thing, but

perhaps Len Bailes can tell us -- I suspect it resembles Cult policies.

For the acquisition of genzines, your best bet is to have something to trade. Extra copies of one of your APazines will usually do, if you include something more than merely mailing comments and your own page or so of Editorial Blither. Otherwise, try letterhacing. It will usually get you a free issue if your letter is printed, and may even do so if it is not printed. Just don't try this method with Coulson -- trade him a zine or subscribe. You'll have to sub to Gibson's G², too, if you want to get it currently.

Of course, you can wait and hope the things you don't get on a current basis will filter down to you as used zines. Then all you need is a definite way to pick up used/old zines. You'll probably need such a scheme anyway, as you will want to get issues of zines published before you started collecting.

Well, you can sometimes buy back issues from hucksters [like me.] If there are only a few special zines you need, this is a fairly good route to them -- one reason why I have taken to selling the duplicates by the item instead of the usual so much per pound or foot of zines, the method used by the fan who wants most to get rid of the dups and have some space. For larger accumulations, the easiest way is to let it be known that you want old fanzines, and are willing to pay at least the postage and handling for them. Other methods of accumulation include the visiting of semi-gafiated fans to see their collections [The "Vulture" approach] and the haunting of convention auctions or club auctions, bidding on the stacks of fanzines that usually come up in foot-high stacks and get knocked down for 50¢ or so.

The next problem in collecting is what to do with the fanzines after you get them. As I said, I have mine in filing cabinets and bound volumes. Files are expensive, but you can probably make do for a while with large boxes or cartons -- cartons which originally held ten reams of paper are a very good place to file zines, as you can get two rows of them in a box by standing them on end. I recommend filing fanzines by title, as it eliminates the problem of cross-filing when a zine goes from one editor to another. On the other hand, I recommend checklisting the zines by editor, using 3x5 cards. With the editor's name at the top of the card, you can list the titles of his zines, and, next to the titles, the numbers of that title you have in your collection. There are special cases where the individual editors should not be placed at the top of the card -- such as when the zine is the OO of an organization. For example, SHANGRI-L'AFFAIRES is listed under LASFS, THE NATIONAL FANTASY FAN under NFFF, etc. But however you decide to arrange it, a checklist is absolutely necessary. A further suggestion: There are a number of ½-size fanzines such as Convention PR's and PB's, INSIDE, RHODOMAGNETIC DIGEST, etc. If you file these in with the regular zines, they will tend to slip down and get lost. Instead, set aside a shelf on your bookcase -- they will fit there quite nicely, and be much more accessible. You can note on the checklist card (by a symbol) that a title is ½-size and therefore is filed outside the main file. Or you can simply remember that such and such a title is half-size -- but this takes a while.

When you get a large number of consecutive issues of a zine, it would pay in terms of ease of handling and availability to have the zine bound. This depends on whether you can afford the cost, which is about \$4.20 a volume. [I send my binding to Florida -- Dobbs Brothers Library Binding Co, 801 Industrial Drive, St. Augustine -- and \$4.20 is their rate for a volume 11" high and about 2½ inches wide.]

What with filing cabinets, checklisting, binding -- not to mention the original acquisition of the zines -- collecting fanzines can be expensive in both time and cash. But it is also enjoyable -- and any hobby gets to be expensive if you go into it deeply. So.....do you really want to be a Fanzine Collector?

= The colophon should include
= the title of the publication, the
= volume and issue number, and/or the
= whole number -- depending on your

numbering system. There should be a date of publication -- month and year will generally suffice. If it is intended for an APA, or is the official publication of an organization, this information should also go into the Colophon, together with the mailing number for which it is intended. And, of course, the name of the editor/publisher should be included.

Sounds like a lot of work, so why should anyone do it? Well, it is to be assumed that one's publications are of some value, however small. They will be saved by the collectors -- both the private individuals and the organizations such as UCLA, the ISL, and a few others that are interested in either the science fiction field or the amateur journalism field. They will be available for future reference -- again assuming that someone will eventually be interested in referring to them. To be able to keep a collection in order you must have colophons that tell you where this particular issue fits into the general run.

Or perhaps you wish to cite an article in one of your fanzines you put out three years ago. If it has no number, no date, how are you going to identify it? A colophon would solve the problem.

For those fans who have many titles, I recommend the Cumulative Numbering system, wherein each title is given a number as part of a series of publications under a house name. If you have no idea of how many zines you have already published, start at #1 of a new house name, and continue from the present -- you'll be better off than you would be with no listing at all. The list, which will help you keep track of the numbers, dates, and APA mailing numbers of all your titles, since you can simply check back and see what the last issue was, can be kept in a small notebook right near the typewriter, so that it is immediately available when you begin a new zine. So you can put the colophon right on the first stencil you begin, and enter it in your list.

Let me take an example or two. How about ELMURMURINGS, the majority of the issues being vol.1 #1, Whole #1. Perdue couldn't care less, it appears, whether anyone can refer to one of his publications; it has served to save his FAPA membership another year, and that's all that matters. Okay; with this attitude toward one's zines, a colophon isn't necessary to the publisher. (It is always necessary to the collector.) But how about something like PAS-TELL? Some of them can be referred to by number and some by date; a few by both. But some of them have neither date nor number, and the pagination may even vary depending on what was clipped to the issue when it was sent out. It would be hell on wheels to refer to an article on, say, the Seacon Art Show. I have the zine it's in, but I can't cite it, for lack of publishing data.

Take pity on the poor neglected colophon -- use it generously!
