INTRODUCTION: This first part of the *British Fanzine Bibliography* deals with the earliest British fanzines, from the first known publication (*Novae Terrae*) in 1936 to the end of 1950. Three further parts are in preparation, covering the period 1951-1975. For the purpose of this bibliography, fanzines are taken to be amateur publications produced by science fiction fans and distributed within sf fandom. Programme booklets and convention newsletters have been included, but sf booklists, library lists, advertising, and sales sheets have been left out.

The information given here represents no more than a provisional listing and is far from comprehensive. It is hoped that from these parts a more complete bibliography can be assembled and that a revised, single volume edition can be published later. Anyone who has access to relevant fanzines is welcome to send additional information to the address above.

The present bibliography has, wherever possible, been compiled from the original fanzines. Some additional information has, however, had to be extracted from comments and reviews in contemporary fanzines. The only previous bibliography, Bill Evans & Bob Pavlat's *Fanzine Index*, has been of substantial help in compiling this first part, as has Bob Pavlat's *FAPA Book* (for fanzines distributed through the Fantasy Amateur Press Association). My thanks to Bob Pavlat and Archie Mercer for their additional help.

The entries are arranged alphabetically by title. When known, the editor's name is given, as well as the place of publication, and any connexion with a local or national sf organization. Individual issues are listed in the following format: 1) issue number (in brackets if it does not appear on the fanzine itself); 2) date (month, or season, and year); 3) method of reproduction (see abbreviations); 4) paper size (see abbreviations); 5) total number of pages, including covers; 6) any additional notes. A question mark indicates that information is lacking.
