SOME MATERIALS TOWARDS A FANZINE INDEX

The First Four N'APA Mailings

::

Key: This information is arranged in the following sequence: item number (I have assigned all N'APAZines a reference number), title, volume and number, page size, number of sheets, number of pages, method of reproduction, editor, and "item in mailing" number.

Abbreviations: concerning page size, S means a standard 8 1/2 x 11 sheet, L means a legal length 8 1/2 x 14 sheet, Q means the British quarto 8 x 10 sheet, and 1/2 S would mean half standard size, etc; concerning method of reproduction, m means mimeographed, d means dittoed, h means hectoed, o means offset, multilith or lithoed, mg means multigraphed, p means printed, ph means photographed, ss means silkscreened, rs means rubber stamped, lino means linoleum block, cr means crayola, ha means hand inked or penciled, phc means photocopied, and c means carbon copied. In cases where several methods were used such as item 99, Belle Dietz's Official Communication, the primary method is listed first.

I have listed all fanzines which I thought were connected with N'APA. Terwillegger, the official editor during this period, did not count or list postmailings to N'APA; therefore all the "mailed separately" items were "illegal", and have been guessed at. Because I used my discretion we see situations where I didn't list Hamlin's The Odd One, even though he said, "I'll see you all get copies of the amish..", while I did count Carlson's Pitcon Memory Book flyer.

Bob Lichtman, who at my request examined this list some time ago, raised a question about item 100, Peals #4. He thought I had received it because I had been in OMPA at that time, and it had been officially postmailed to that organization. I asked Frank Dietz about this, who looked over that issue and found a note in the letter column: "This issue will have a wider circulation than just OMPA and N'APA by about 100 copies." I am retaining Peals #4 as item 100. I find it interesting that we turned out exactly 100 fanzines in our first four mailings.
