

I may perhaps have mentioned earlier that not all of my fanzines bear numbers as Demented Turkish Dwarf Press publications. The criteria as to which are and which aren't Dwarf-PressPubs are rather complex, and I shan't go into them here (because I haven't the foggiest notion what they are), but I list the others every hundred zines just for my own entertainment, so I'll know how many zines I've done altogether. My earliest zines (predating the DwarfPressPubs by a whole year, in fact) were done for the New Orleans Science Fiction Association, so let's start with those.

A grand total of 463 fanzines for which I count myself more-or-less responsible. Since I've been publishing them a few months short of nine years (Nolazine #1, my first, came out Aug. 19, 1967), that averages out to more than a zine a week. Gaah! Is there anyone else who has kept up that sort of average for so long a time? (Yeah, no doubt a few people have been contributing to Apa-L that long, but that kind of average is still pretty remarkable.)

LATE-BREAKING NEWS: When I went to put the zines away after listing them, I found, on the bottom of the stack, some incunabula that I've never counted among my zines before, but that I'm still responsible for. Particularly, the DeepSouthCon-6 Program Booklet and a bunch of other DSC-6 publications that I didn't write but may or may not have run off (but wen't count because I think they were run off by Pat Adkins). Also, a note that I pasted up illos on Nolazine #13, making it at least partially my zine. So add two to the NOSFA zines and make it 465 total. I think that's everything, but with the way I keep records it's hard to tell. No doubt the minute this stencil is out of the machine, I'll find more.
