
AUSSICON '75

Dear People,

I just returned from Midwestcon where I had great fun listening to people making plans for the trip to Australia. There certainly are a variety of plans for those "do-your-own-thing" days between the con and the trip to New Zealand. Some people are renting a car, others are flying everywhere, others (including Don and myself) are going to travel by train using the Austrailpass.

I am enclosing the latest information from the travel agent as well as a "do-it-yourself" bill since there are so many things that must be purchased before we leave the U.S. From the items listed, please select those that you want. The only item that must be on everyone's bill is the basic required package of \$953.10.

I don't believe it but it is true. Those add-on fares that I have been talking about since the beginning have been discontinued!!! However, our travel agent has hunted for the lowest possible fare that we can use. This ITX fare however has some restriction, the biggest ones being that travel is not permitted 2:01 p.m. Friday to 11:59 p.m. Friday and 2:01 Sunday to 11:59 p.m. Sunday. These times refer to scheduled take-off time, or if there is a connecting flight, the connecting flight cannot take-off during those hours. We know that this ruins the plans of those of us (including Don and myself) who were planning to fly to Los Angeles Friday afternoon to attend the party Friday night. (I will fly to L.A. on Friday morning.) If you want this add-on fare please indicate when you want to leave and any other information that will help the travel agent in ticketing you.

There is an extra charge if you are planning on single accommodations for the hotels. If you do not have a roommmate but would like one, please indicate where asked for the name of your roommmate. I know that some people are looking for someone to share the hotel accommodations so please let us know if you are still looking. We will do the best we can about pairing people but switching can be done later after the group meets in Los Angeles.

If you wish to purchase a TAA 30% discount ticket, please list the route that you wish to take. To figure out the price of your TAA ticket, add together the fares for the various segments of your trip and multiple by 1.216 which will give you the price in American dollars. The fares between the various cities were given in the chart in Aussiecon Flyer #7.


