Last year John Foyster inaugurated the Egoboo Poll - or Anazapopoll, as I've just this minute remembered he called it - and, largely I suspect because John declared himself ineligible, I had the happiness of winning. I undertook to conduct a similar poll this year, and here we are. Since an opportunity to type this and my proximity to a copy of last year's poll have not coincided, I have had the pleasure of working out a set of categories from scratch, and I can only hope they will be found a reasonable survey of the areas in which members are interested as readers, writers and publishers.

In each category a maximum number of points is to be distributed. For example, in "Fiction" you may award all 10 points to one person, or distribute them among any number of persons, or award less than 10 points to one person, or distribute less than 10 points among any number of persons, or not award any points at all. I do hope that is clear.

A bonus of 5 points will be awarded to every member who returns this form, completed legibly and in accordance with the rules, by the closing date.

Here are the rules. You may not vote for yourself. In the event of your winning, you undertake to conduct next year's poll. You may not (no matter how much it hurts) vote for me. You must return this form to me, not to our over-worked Official Editor.

And here are some special provisions. Overseas members may return their votes by 15th September, and they need not use this form. Australian members may also return their votes by 15th September, but they will lose their bonus points.

Any person who has been a member of ANZAPA at any time between mailings 7 to 12 inclusive (ie, October 1969 to August 1970) may be awarded votes, but only members listed in the 12th mailing may cast votes.

No correspondence will be entered into, no bribes accepted (rather, they'll be accepted all right, but they won't make any difference to the tally), the male shall be imputed to include the female, the singular the plural and the isosceles the tetrahedron, except where damaging to any character real or imaginary, at rest or in motion, nor where contrary to post office regulations and the ordinances of holy writ. So there.
