Possible SMOFcon activities:

Create-a-Con: Part of the convention program will be a special series of how-to basics for new con workers and those people thinking about working in a new area.

Thinking It Through: A pre-con series of articles by fen who are considered authorities on particular topics. These would be "how-to" articles -- how they do it, and how they think through an activity as they are planning it. These articles would form the core of follow-up panels on the topics. Yes, we would ask people to read (gasp!) the articles before they attend the panel.

Breaking Traditions: A series of panels looking at the way we have done things and what new directions or evolving innovations we should be contemplating. This might include a brainstorming panel for ideas, after which we could schedule some follow-up panels for the Thinking It Through part of the theme.

Since we will be on the Spacecoast, we are negotiating for a tour of Kennedy Space Center on Friday morning. We plan to videotape all the programs to have them available as references and for those who can't make the con.
