First，let us appreciato the dinonsions of our problemo Th the foreigh Iiola it appears that the American taxpayers，who have novar krom military dofeaty have beon compellod to pay more troasure into the coffers of foreier powern than ill the vancuishod pooplo in hiatory have yaid to theix concuenore．

On the domestic scene the buroaucrotic concuesti of the Anexican taxpayer
is fantantic．Moro than 700 Federal corporate activitios，oxistine without tice slicilatest pretense of conctitutional authority，ride tho backs of the American people 0,5 interest free，dividend free，rent free，cost freo，tax free competitors of taxpaying producers and conaumers．
liost jeople recall that our Constitution was designed to prevent this concuost but the tax collectors keep us much too busy ammine enough to satisfy thais demands to know much ebout tho details of whit has happoncd or why Assuming trat the function of dovermment is the protoction of life and propertys we have paid littlo hoed to the enomous conquest of our land by Foderal acencieso

To get a comprehensive view of this phase or the problom，lut u，s tum to the U．S．Govemment Organdaational Manual and se日 what some of the pederal agencies have to say about themselves。

On pace 221 of the 1958－9 issue of this menual the Interiox Departmant describes its vast empiro by assarting that it has oustody of 750 milition ecres of land．Thus this singlo agency clains to have jurisdiction over 32.3 percent of the total land and water aroa of the United States and all of its temaitorion and possessions．

On pace 254 of tho same，manual the Forest Sorvice olaims that it administers about 183 milion acres，his acrearge equals 801 percent of the total land ard water aroa of the Unitod staios and all its tornitorios and possessionso
this citos the landholding of but 2 of the more than 700 Foderal agencias wich have in sone way invadod prjvate enterprise．this by no means is all tho landholding in the horis of such arencies：as most of those listod have undertaken to build landed estates for thenselvas．However，these two are the lareest landholderse They havo jojntiy tajen over an area graater in extent than the conbined land arca of 25 shropean countriesc thess are：

上neland，Ireland，Scotland，Wales，Portugal．Spain，Franco，Holeium，Holland． Luxembourgs Switzorland，Cormany，Icoland，Denmaik，Poland，Crechoslovakia， Austria，Hungary，ltalys INonaco，Albaniay Greece，Yuçoslavia，Iunania，and Bulgarla．

This constitutes quite a conquers in itsalf。 Added to the other areas taken over by other Fedoral acencios，the non－terapaying but tax uppoztod political empires cone close to roprosentine tho majozty intorcel in the United states
 Stato juriadictiono Tho woblora is furthor complicuted onen we roaljau that fully 20 percont of the inductrial capacity of tho $\mathbb{N}$ ation is losated on this land，under tho control of and operated by the＂edoral afencies on an interee free，dividend froe，rent frec，and tax free bagis．This makes one wonder what happened to the American institution of＂equal justice fox all＂to which we pledge our allogiance during oach flag coremony。

This sumuary of problems has no value unless we are willing to uillize tie information as the basis for the development of a solution．It should be readily apparent to everyone that the fabulous costs of these political empires is the primary reason for our high taxes．It is aimple logic，thon，to presume that by oliminating the problem of Federal invasion of privato entorprise we would at the same timo climiniute much of our tax problemo

While tho problems appear to be massive，and ony solution necessarily complex， the facts indicate that all tho oloments which constitute the problems are soluble by giving new force and effect to the original purposes of the Constitu－ tion．The answer to a few busic questions macht help to clarify the iroblomg its solution，and the manner of its application。
（uestion NO 1。 Wat 1 is it the Federal corporato activities do？
Answer．Those Federal acencies havo invaded as active competitorn almost overy ficle of human vocations

Guostion No 2．Where did these Federal agencies cet tho capital to go into． buainose as competitors to privete citizens？

Answer．The American peoplo wore required to provide the capital－an estimated $\$ 250$ billion eathered throush tares or included in the national debt．for the accuisition of the land，plants，and facilities involved．
vastion No 3．Do these Federal corporate 玉etivities oparate with conetf＝ tutional authority？

Answor．HO。 Actually the intent and purpose of the Constitution was to guard against such aotivitics boine undertaken by covernment．The Foderal corporate activitios exoroise powext without constitutional authority and have survived through a process of seleotive law anforcement which fosters political violation of the spirit，intent，and purpose of the Eonstitution．

Suestion Ho 4．Do the Federal corporate activities pay their own way？
Answer．No，They have made claime of paying theix own way on occasiong but such claims arc based upon extraordinary and unrealistic accounting practices which would not be pemitted to privato enterprise，and do not include such normal items as cost of space consumed，many operational costs，interest，dividenis． and taxeso Each year theso agencies sook addtional tax dollars to pay their lossos，undorwrite their peyroll，and aministration or to finance lidden costs

Cuestion No 50 Do the Fedoral corporato aotivitios esaus the responsibilitios undertaken by private enterprise？

Answero No，Instoud of eswung nomal operatine reeponsibilities，and supportine the oivic interests they demand servioes of all kinds fror every lovel of Eovemment．Deapire this political proference and privilege，which is contrary to our Anericari concept of equality and justice，the Fedoral corporate activitica have consistently lost more than $\$ 10$ billion per year since 1948 ，and in 1959 the lossos are estinatod to excoed 19 billionn

Guestion No 6。 Isnt it true that these Federal corporate activitios heve only been developod to provide us with the foods and sexvicos which wrivate ontorpuise has failed or refused to provide？

Answer．No．The contention that private anterprise either failod or refuaed to porform in any oconomic area has no basis in fact．Political force has frecuently prevented private entorprise from flunctioning，but J．find mo instano in which private enterpirise has failed to meet the challence when it has beon free to do so．In every cese，wihhout oxception，privato enterprisc has deariu strated the capacity to produce more and bettor foods and sexvices hín Ris infinitely lover actual coet than any eavemmantal aconoy has reocuiako

Unfortunetway the polition empre builden are not dotarad by such. facts thoy wiy on political privilego jomer thon prochocive excelience and seck to wee tho foxce of fovernnert to suadue competition that they may dominate thoiz fjelda.

Fron thein vantage point of political proveronce and prestige, with easy access to fabulcus quantities o: our tax dollarsy and with tumunty from the lawn whioh govern the rest of usg tho Foderal corporate activities devrate themselves to expansiono they fight to maintain and expand their lush positions of power, using the malth and means of the paople they attack to susitait their conquast.
buestion No 7e What can we do to control such practices and reestablish constitutional protection for oun individual prosporitios and onterprise?

Answar. We can follow the partern estabiished by tio Founding Fatherso They fashioned our Constitutiong in whici they delogated to goverment a fews limitied: and carefully designated powerno Not satisficd with paricularw iaing the powers delegated, the first 10 amendments to tia Constitution were added to prohibit fovemmental exercise of any othez powoaso

The ninth mendment reads: "The exumeration of the Constitiotiong of cortain tights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people."

The 50 th amendment readss "The powers not dolegated to tha United States by the Constitutions nor prohibited. by it to the $S t e t \in \mathrm{~s}_{\mathrm{j}}$ are reserred to the States respectively, or to the people."

Those stipulations are clear and concise, but they are not seititorforoingo They mecurre continuous support of ineormed fublic opinion to be kept in full force and effecto They heve not had this supporto jititle by iftilen through a Ionc sexies of legislative acts, powers which the Government does nct possess bave been delegated to governmental agencies, authoriajng various onterpriseso These statutes axe invariably acompanied by declaxatzons as ligh parpose, and thus pubije resistance is lujlea and puolic apathy is nourichoc.

Now wo become arrare of the enomous political powor whtch has been symoned from us through this process, Tie are confronted withathe eccumajative host of polition empires which hold 40 porcent of the land axae and 20 percent of the fndustrins capadity of tho Nationg and absort mong then helí the toval rovense
 hiddea costs,

Whth this realication we should also understand that we have the pewer to correot the problemo lio can do this hy going bock to tiset patncipios and again apelling out tho teams of our aconomic freenom in the Constitution. Only in this way can we aboltsh those pactices which we knovy to bo antagonistite to our inistorys tradition, and wellebeing. By regaining our econoinio liberty in this maner: we can elimanase the taxes which Eustain this buneancratic competition aseinst us,

Gestion wo 8, What device can be used to obtajn these objectivas?

Guestion he．90 What is the procead for ading this anendment to the Constitution？

Answaro Aocordine to the fifth article of the Constitution，two－thirds of both Iouses of Congress conourring can injtiato the arnendment，or，when the legislatares of tryo－tiinds of the States edoph a resolution identical to that adopted by Yoring and Tezas．Congress will be required to dall a． constitutional zonvention to submit the amendment to the States for ratifications
 of the States 60 becone a part of the Constitution。

Question 10 O 10 ．How would the properties and facilities of the Faderal comporations bo sold back to the American poople，and how would this alter the casts of Government？

Answor．Congyess mould make the miles governing the salo of the properties tu the people，and rould supervise the process．It is estimated that the land，buildinç and facilitios，even under the worst conditions，would bring better than $\$ 65$ billion，all of which would do applied to the national dobto The House Governmentel Operations Comittee estimates the Covermmentis invostment in their propexties to be $\$ 262$ billiono We ostimate a mixiram I oturn of 25 percont of this figure although recent salos of Govorimont property，such as tho syinthotic rubbor plants and property at Oak Rjage，Tonnos returnod about three tines the book ralue．However，by retirine only i65 billion of the rationel dobt the intorost charges on this mould save the taxpeyors about $\$ 1,950 \mathrm{mil1ion}$ in suoh a yoar as 1959．

Instead of our Governmont boing the greatest pauper in histoxy it will be retumed to a solven＇c position and regain the affection of its citizens，and the affection of the citizen is the greatest asset any govermant can possibly onjoy．

Solution of these problems at the national level will coxtributo onormously to the solution of many related problems closer to us．Think of the advantege to eyexy businasman when the threat of Federal costhfiseg rentofrae，tax－irse． outthroat competition is romoved。Consider the endleak benoizts to come Ircu e people winose genius is no longer restrained by political atwaitfockets or the blight of impossible taxationo

In camh Stateg in each city，and to eaoh percong the situation dipforay but in orny instancoy mithcut exceptions the acmomic ireedom restorad to us through the terms of tho proposed 23d anendment means an indinito verietivy of benefactiona beycnd our sapeaity to imagine，just as the Constitution itsali beld sdventages for us lar beyond the dxoams of those who gave it iffe。

Even the conflict botrion labor and managoment will be large Iy resolved by the amendment beoause 1t will restore to labor the reward for its foid which is now boing taken away through the withholding tax．This will puta greater mot inorease into the pay envelope of ewory American thas any poido tiolan or my labor leader ewer dared to promise．
