## RESULTS OF THE BALLOT FOR DUFF 1986

There were 168 votes cast in the 1986 DUFF race: 53 in Australia (compared to 39 in 1985 and 38 in 1984) and 115 in the US (compared to 154 in 1985 and 63 in 1984). These were the primary votes cast in each country:

- AUSTRALIA: SBeasley 2; TFrost 5; Loney/Muysert 6; Morley/Fride/Stathopoulos 39; No Freference 1.
- USA: Beasley 37; Frost 25; Loney/Muysert 13; Morley/Fride/Stathopoulos 15; Hold Cver 10; No Freference 12; Write-In 3 (John Bangsund 2, Wal Footrot 1).

Sally Beasley had resigned from the race owing to inability to attend Confederation, so her votes were distributed first. That distribution and subsequent ones are detailed on the following table:

DUFF 1987: DUFF will be paying for a delgate to CAPCON, the 1987 Aussie Natcon. To qualify, a candidate needs 2 Australian and 3 American nominators; they will need to post a bond of \$10 and submit a

100 word policy statement. Nominations are likely to close around the time of worldcon and further details will be published by the new administrators. Meanwhile, consider Americans worth nominating and get them motivated.
