APPLICANTS FOR MEMBERSHIP MUST FILL OUT A REGISTRATION BLANK FURNISHED BY THE LEAGUE AND RETURN IT TO THE SECRETARY. THEY MUST ATTEND TWO CONSECUTIVE MEETINGS AFTER WHICH TIME THEY MUST BE VOTED INTO THE LEAGUE BY A THREE QUARTERS MAJORITY OF THOSE MEMBERS PRESENT AT ANY ONE OFFICIAL BUSINESS MEETING. Upon being voted into the League, they will be required to pay their intiation fee and their first years dues. Those residing outside the area covered by the Detroit City telephone directory may become associate members of the League with all benefits and privileges of regular members except that of voting. Associate members do not have to attend two meetings but his name will be read at two meetings after which a vote will be taken. The dues for regular members shall be \$1.50 per year and for associate members, \$1.00 per year. The initiation fee shall be 50% for all new members when first joining up.
