


OPEN LETTER

TO MEMBERS OF THE DETROIT SCIENCE FANTASY LEAGUE TO MEMBERS OF THE WOLVERINE INSURGENTS

Some time after this, these same Saginaw fen organized themselves into a group they called the Wolverine Insurgents. Even though they seemed to think that the Etroit group was demeath their notice we see that they are coming down to a good many of our meetings, regardless of the Weather.

AUTHOR DEAD

DEATH COMES TO BURROUGHS

HEART ATTACK FATAL TO TARZAN'S CREATOR

EDGAR RICE BURROUGHS! WHOSE OWN TWIST ON THE THEORY OF EVOLUTION---TARZAN----BROUGHT RICHES THAT DARWIN NEVER DREAMED OF IS DEAD:

BURROUGHS, AUTHOR, DIED MARCH 19, BUT THE APE-MAN HE CREATED WILL LIVE ON TO DELIGHT OTHER GENERATIONS OF YOUNGSTERS THE WORLD OVER.

FIFTEEN NOVELS WERE AWAITING PUB-LICATION WHEN BURROUGHS, 74, DIED OF A

HEART ATTACK IN BED. A MOVIE PRODUCER SAID HE HAD CON-

TRACTED TO MAKE 15 MORE TARZAN FILMS.

"TARZAN OF THE APES" BROUGHT BURROUGHS ONLY \$700. AFTER ITS PHENOMENTAL SUCCESS, HE RETAINED CONTROL OVER HIS
LITERARY WORKS AND THE ROYALTIES REACHED FABULOUS PROPORTIONS. FROM MOVIE RIGHTS ALONE HE IS REPORTED TO HAVE REALIZED \$5,000,000.

ALMOST 40,000,000 TARZAN BOOKS HAVE BEEN SOLD. THE APE-MAN, PORTRAYED BY SUCH ACTORS AS JOHNNY EISSMULLER, BUSTER CRABBE AND CURRENTLY LEX BARKER, HAS APPEARED IN 27

MOVIES.

SHORTLY AFTER THE SALE OF HIS FIRST BOOKS, BURROUGHS, BOUGHT AN ESTATE IN THE SUBURBS OF LOS ANGELES AND BUILT A HOME, "TARZANA," IN ITS CENTER. HE SUBDIVIDED THE PROPERTY AND THE CITY OF TARZANA GREW UP A ROUND HIS HOME.

HE SOLD THE HOUSE AFTER HE AND THE FORMER EMMA HUL-BERT, WHOME HE MARRIED IN 1900, WERE DIVORCED IN 1934. A YEAR LATER HE MARRIED FLORENCE DEARHOLDT. THAT MARRIAGE ENDED IN DIVORCE IN 1941. HE HAD THREE CHILDREN, JOAN, JOHN AND HOLBERT, BY HIS FIRST MARRIAGE.

BURROUGHS MOVED TO HONOLULU A FEW MONTHS BEFORE PEARL HARBOR AND WATCHED THE JAPANESE ATTACK. AS A WAR CORRESPONDENT DESPITE HIS AGE, HE TRAVELED FROM ISLAND TO ISLAND WITH THE ARMED FORCES FOR FOUR YEARS:

HE WAS 35 WHEN HE BEGAN WRITING. BEFORE THEN HE HAD BEEN A SALESMAN, CLERK, COWBOY, GOLD MINER AND RAILROAD GUARD. BURROUGHS NEVER REGARDED HIS WORKS AS MASTERPIECES. "IT HELPED ME ESCAPE BEING BROKE," HE SAID.

HUNDREDS SIGN UP FOR ROCKET TRIP

RESERVATIONS ROCKETED AT THE WORLD'S FIRST TRAVEL BUREAU FOR TRIPS TO THE MOON AND THE PLANETS.


