THE SECOND TUCKER FAN SURVEY

INTRODUCTION by BOB TUCKER

Some six years ago I launched an exhaustive inquiry into fannish minds and fannish homes; the mailman staggered under the burden of delivering better than five hundred copies of a long questionaire to every known fan in the world --- or at least, to every known fan who could be located and contacted without the necessity of first submitting the questionaire to a censor or warden. This survey asked several hundred questions about the fan, his life, loves and habits, and resulted in a wealth of information on what makes Joe Fann tick.

Today the survey is again being taken; a slightly modernized survey with a general circulation far in excess of that primitive five hundred a few years ago. Your co-operation is asked, urged and needed to compile a really comprehensive picture of this latter-day Joe Fann. Is he essentially the same as yesterday? Does he still hope to marry a fanne or has he married her? What does he think of interplanetary flight now? Has his sex-ratio changed? Are there more drunkards? Surely the ownership of television sets have increased? Are fanzines still as putrid as they once were? Have clubs improved or are they still muddling along? What can be the purpose of fandom today, as contrasted to yesterday?

And there are several hundred other questions to be answered here. I concur with the editors in asking you to answer them.

INTRODUCTION and INSTRUCTIONS by GERALD A. STEWARD.

Every time I fill out one of those "What did you think of this issue" questionaires which various faneds send out with their zines, I get the recurring wish that someone would do a truly fan-wide survey. Not since Tucker in 1948 has anyone undertaken this project, so.....

The purpose of this survey is to gather information about fans, for fans. All I ask you to do is answer the questions honestly and sensibly. Any questionaire which is returned with "snide" or "witty" answers will be disregarded. The survey is anonymous to protect your privacy and to prompt truthful answers. The questionaire has been made as simple as possible; all that is required is a checkmark beside a "yes" or "no" answer, or one of the answers supplied, or at the most, a short sentence.

This questionaire is being distributed through several fanzines, Canadian Fandom, Escape, Psychotic, and Varioso; and through FAPA by Damn!, through SAPS by Nandu; and at the World Con at San Francisco. There will doubtlessly be much duplication, so if you receive two or more questionaires, please file only one and send the remainder on to some fan friend who might not have received any.

returned. No deadline has been set as yet, if and when one is needed, it will be announced through the distributory fanmags.

I would like to thank Fred Woroch, Richard Geis, John Magnus, Norm Browne, and Nan Gerding for their co-operation in assisting me in distributing this questionaire on a fan-wide basis. The results of the survey will appear in all of these fanmags.

Although the majority of the work on this questionaire is being done by myself, this FAN SURVEY is none-the-less basically the work of Wilson (Bob) Tucker, and should be considered his survey. I would like to give a special mention of thanks to Bob for his assistance and advice on this project.
