# President's Report

This is the annual election. In addition to the usual officers, there are 3 amendments, as listed in the last FA:

- [1] Proposed, that the following be added to the FAPA Constitution as Section 2.6: Any person who is, or has been, a member in the amateur press group known as the Cult shall be excluded from membership.

Proposed by Sneary, Pelz, Ellington,  
Ellik and Dees

- [2] Proposed, that Section 3.2 of the FAPA Constitution be amended by replacing its 3rd (final) sentence with the following: In the mailing following the distribution of the poll, the OE will distribute a ballot listing the names, to be voted on individually, of any waiting listers objected to by 10 or more members. This ballot shall have an approximate two-month voting deadline, and shall be tabulated by the Secretary-Treasurer. A list of those voting shall be published in the FA, but not how they voted individually. Any such waiting lister receiving more unfavorable than favorable votes in this balloting shall be dropped from the waiting list and barred from it and from the FAPA for the next four mailings.

- [3] Proposed, that Section 3.4 of the FAPA Constitution be amended to read as follows: 3.4. Renewal dues must be paid so as to be received by the Treasurer not later than 4 weeks (6 weeks for overseas members) after the mailing date of the fourth mailing of the member's current membership.

and Evans.

To those of you who signed the proposed special rule on behalf of Demmon, the special rule was not needed, nor would it have been legal since it was not distributed to the entire membership.

\*\*Regarding Bill Morse's dues, they are considered constructively received. He telegraphed me that they had been dispatched, but to make allowance for the Canadian postal strike. I am making such allowance.

Lee Hoffman requested a ruling on page credit assignable to cannon balls mailed through FAPA. Lee, it depends on how many sides are printed.

The Waiting List: It increased slightly from last time, but this is normal. No requirement for response, etc, is imposed on the WL this mailing. Next mailing waiting listers can expect to be required to send money for the following year's FA--if I'm Sec Treas at the time there will be no time extension this year, barring further WL antics by the membership. Potential new waiting listers are required to pay 10¢ fee for the FA and to cite credentials.

# Vice President's Report

I have been reluctantly persuaded by the other officers that no credit can be allowed for material published after the fourth mailing of a membership year. In other words, if your last mailing is November, and you publish and postmail a 100-page fanzine in December (incurring the wrath of the PO by aggravating the Christmas rush), you have still to publish 8 pages between February and November in order to be able to renew.

This decision is based primarily on section 2.3 of the Constitution; membership begins upon the date set for the next quarterly mailing. No credit can be given before a person is a member, or before he has renewed his membership ("Dues are \$3 per year," says Section 4.1, defining the membership.)

Dissidents will be unhappy to learn that Martin had no grounds for renewal of his membership, even granting the activity. According to Pavlat, "Ed Martin's membership card shows dues paid through Feb. 62 with no notation of later payment. The Journal, from 30 September 1961 through May 62, shows no payment or refund of dues by or to Martin.

That is about it. See you all in London.
