Any such waiting lister receiving more unfavorable than favorable votes in this ballocin shall b= dropped from the waitinj list and barred from it and from the FAPA for the next four mailings.

Next mailing waiting listers can expect to be required to send money for the following year's FA--if I'm Sec Treas at the time there will be no time extension this year, barring further wL antics by the membership. Potential new waiting listers are required to pay $10 \phi$ fee for the $F A$ and to cite credentials.

# Vice Bresident's Report 

I have bcea reluctantly persuaded by the other officers that no credit can be allowal for material published after the fourth mailing of a membership yan:-. In other words, if your last mailing is Novamber, and you publisin and postmail a 100 -paje fanzine in December (incuraing the wrath of the PO by aggrevating the Christmas rush), you have still to publish 8 pages betwe=n February and November in order to be able to renew.

This decision is based aimarily on section 2.3 of the Constitution; membership beins upon the date set for the next quarterly mailing. No credit cain bc given before a person is a member, or before he has renewed his mombership ("Dues are $\$ 3$ per year," says Section 4.1 , defining the membership.)

Dissidents will be unhapyy to learn that Martin had no grounds for renewal of his membership, even zrantinj the activity. According to avlat, "Ed Martin's membership card shows dues paid throuzh Fcb. 62 with no notation of later payment. The Journal, from 30 September 1 OCl through May 62, shows no payment or refund of dues by or to nartin.
