

With the death of Harold Palmer Piser and the destruction of
all his files, by his own request, a great body of bibliophilic work
has been lost to us. Whatever value it might, or might not have had,
it does remind me of a recurring question. Where is all the FAPA
material? Many years ago Walter Coslet, and probably others, brought
this up. He may even have volunteered to gather it and keep it. Now
is not too soon, or late, to reconsider the problem. If it means
anything to the membership as an entity. Does anybody have any of
the original correspondence relating to the formation of the F.A.P.A?
Where are all of the election records? The egoboo poll papers?
(I've kept all materials from polls and elections, etc.) Corres-
pondence among officers and principals in major constitution changes
and Debates and so on. Does anybody care?

Possibly not but with a growing awareness thruout fandom of a
sense of history of fandom as a dynamic body, perhaps we might just
gather the loose strings. In a time when a book can be published
not only as a labor of love but as a fair proposition of paying for
itself, at the least, on the history of fandom, FAPA might look
back and examine its own beginnings.

Perhaps Harry Warner's book will give a good start in that
direction. I'm assuming the formation of FAPA is covered to some

VICE PRESIDENTS REPORT:

THE 1968 FAPA EGOBOO POLL RESULTS

We received 14 ballots, down two from last year (down six from year before last)...

The voters were: Greg Benford, F. M. Busby, Ed Cox, Mike Deckinger, Gordon Eklund, Dick Ellington, Bob Leman, Bob Lichtman, The Moffatts, Bill Rotsler, Rick Sneary, Roy Tackett, Harry Warner and Stan Woolston.

Obviously, our attempt to simplify the Poll was a waste of time, as it did not produce the desired result, i.e., the participation of more members in the Poll. We submit that no matter how the poll is set up, only a few members are going to vote, and that the greater majority of the membership is not interested.

F. M. Busby had a comment on his ballot, as follows: "Approximately 1962, Section 2.5 was amended so that dual memberships are entitled to two Poll ballots. Since then, we've received the two ballots exactly once, and voted them that time. This is the first ballot I've voted in about 4 years, and that seems reasonable, considering."

We could find no such amendment in the FAPA Constituion as published in FA 126. But we weren't in FAPA in 1962, so we can't really argue the point one way or t'other. We appeal to the FAPA historians for advice on this matter.

As is usual (we guess), there was at least one voter who voted for a name not on the membership list, and more than one voter who voted for publications that did not appear in--and were not postmailed to--the four mailings in question. None of these points were included in the tabulations.

Membership

- D -- dues of \$4.00/year for North American members, \$2.50/year for overseas, are due by 8 Aug, 1969.
- \$ -- dues are due by 10 May, and have not yet been received. If not in before you read this, you are out, unless you invoke Sect 3.3, 3.5, or 9.1 of the Constitution.
- A -- the number of standard pages indicated following the renewal month must be published before or in the next mailing to make you eligible to renew. Material in this mailing has not yet been credited.
- ATM -- activity, as indicated, is due in this mailing, or postmailed before the mailing deadline, May 10.
- AMay -- as a new member, Sect 2.4 requires that you publish your first year's renewal credits of 8 pages before or in the third mailing, or your membership is cancelled and you do not get that third mailing -- one one indicated.
- [1] -- funds on deposit. I have deducted, where enough was on deposit, for May renewals, but not for August.
