OE's message:

On occasions, as last mailing, you will find a FAPA magazine in the bundle that is not listed in the FA. On a rare occasion this could be oversight. Anything I receive after that time, but before bundle stuffing begins (Sunday afternoon or evening) is included in the bundle even tho not listed in the FA.

Foyster and Coulson found I'd shorted their bundle of at least one item last mailing. Hope anyone else missing anything will advise me before the surplus stock sale gets too far along. You might want to particularly check for the A Propos de Rien 130 and Synapse which were last minute additions to the last mailing but not listed in the FA for reasons given above.

VEEP REPORT: EGOBOO POLL '70

I don't know if 14 votes is a record low-water mark in recent Fäpal history, tho I admit being just as ahppy there weren't more by the time I finished totting up the tallies.

Those who voted -- in alphabetical order -- were: Benford, Calkins, Ellington, Grennell, Hickey, R&P Pavlat, Raeburn, Rotsler, Scithers, Sneary, Speer, Tackett, Warner and Wells. Each received ten points for voting, with five apiece going to Bob and Peggy Pavlat.

Joint memberships created varying amounts of confusion, as usual. In the nick of time, I noticed that SERCON'S BANE is credited to F. M. Busby, which resolved that particular dilemma. Horib is credited to Dick Lupoff, so no problem there, but Vandy carries a split byline and there seemed no way to locate the Hartford City Publishing Jiants on the Totem Poll of Fapa in the position they certainly deserve.

In the interest of maintaining some degree of perspective, it may be noted that on voter voiced the sentiment that the entire thing was a farce, anyway, casting a total of 170 votes for Warner, including -- for the love of God, Montresor -- a full 15 as unsung Fapan...with 25 points for Dominic Benford as Best Single Publication (a charming sentiment, but declared invalid on grounds that the press-run was 67 copies short.)

It might be well if someone circulated a procedure-sheet for fledgling veeps, as I was of the erroneous impression that voting covered the mailing in which the ballots appeared plus the three previous mailings. Peggy Rae's helpful postmailing rectified this booboo and only two votes covered items in the 130th mailing. I counted these votes and they are shown in parentheses as an increment which follows the full total.
