PRESIDENTIALLY PROFFERED

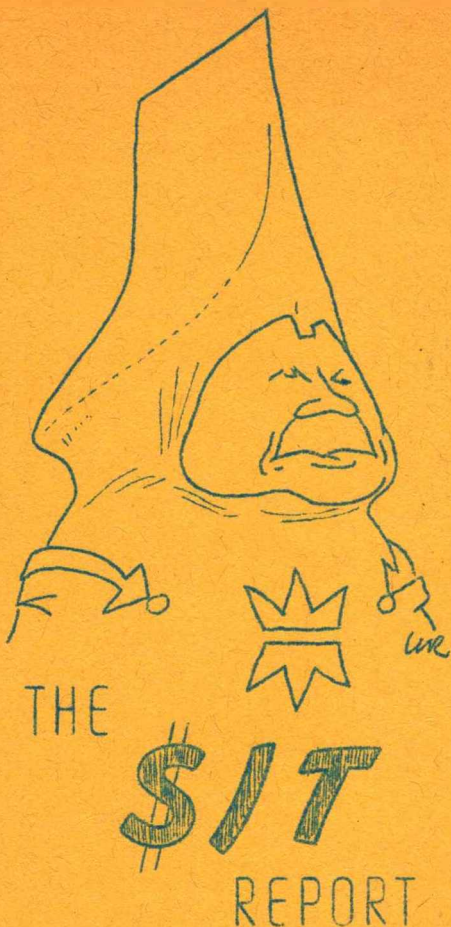

The following is the status of the FAPA membership as of November 6, 1974 (now that Discon II and the "Watergate election" are over). As usual, the symbols mean:

- A -The number of pages indicated must be published before or in the next mailing, or postmailed before the next deadline date, or you will be ineligible to renew. Material in this mailing has not yet been counted.
- ATM -The indicated number of pages must be in this mailing, or have been postmailed before the deadline of this mailing, or you are out unless you circulate a petition under Section 3.2, 3.3 or 3.5. If you do, please inform me.
- AFeb -Indicates that as a new member your renewal credentials must be published in or before the specified mailing or you will not get that mailing and your membership is cancelled (Section 2.4).
- D -Dues of \$2/year (overseas \$1/year) are due before the next deadline if you intend to renew.
- \$ -Dues as above are due before the current deadline or you are out, subject to petition as above.
- (2) -Funds on deposit. Note that I have not yet deducted for February renewals but I will

do so. In this case, the D is merely a formal notice.
