OF MEMBERS AND 'ZINES (and Egoboo Polls), February 1989, is compiled by Peggy Rae Pavlat of 5709 Goucher Drive, College Park, Maryland USA 20740.

The name of the fanzine, the date of the FAPA mailing and the number of papers for each member's FAPA activity, whether it is published in that member's zine or in another member's is indicated in Of Members and 'Zines. The index tends to ignore franked material. Letters which are printed credited to "Arthur" or "George" are likewise ignored in frustration unless the author is apparent from the context.

The intention of the index is to make it easier to vote in the FAPA Egoboo Poll which should be included in this mailing. Someone commented, in a recent mailing, that it might not be fair for me to note some special things about some zines in this index (such as the trip report by Jack Speer's brother), since I didn't make similar comments about others. Whether any fanzine benefits in the Egoboo Poll probably could be easily refuted, but might still be left in doubt by looking at the fanzine/editor's ratings in years when I made a comment and comparing that to their ratings in years when I didn't make a comment. If there is a positive corrolation, then still open to interpretation is if the increased votes for that magazine/editor is because of my notation or because it was particularly well done. I'm inclined to keep making notes when I want to, because this index is being done in part to help me find things. And besides, I smile when I see the note, because it brings the material back to me. And smiling is good.

This year I've enjoyed the May, August and November bundles more than any in recent memory. Thanks for sharing your lives and interests.

Notations to the right of the mailing date (Feb, May, Aug, Nov) signify that the person post-mailed the material (PM) to the mailing noted or had material in another person's fanzine (let = letter; art = art; article = article). I do not have any post-mailings this year. That seems unusual.

When the publisher/editor of a fanzine is a member of FAPA and material by another member included within the fanzine is indexed, the editor/publisher is noted in parenthesis immediately after the title of the fanzine. If no activity is noted after a person's name, then no activity was noted in the mailings or postmailings.

Jack Speer (May 1988) notes that I had four issues for Warner in the 1987 index, as if this were a mistake. I had three issues in the 1986 index for Warner.

Bob Rogers says that his Masks was in the November 1987 mailing. It wasn't in mine. (Seth, Bob, do you have any left? If so, I'd really like one!)

Notations of which individuals held FAPA office during 1988 are also included in the index.

Glad to see that Gregg and his ramblings are back. Sorry that Uncle Ghod won't be with us any longer. Elmer's was one of the zines I always made time to read, even when I was really busy. He'll be missed.
