Actually, if I were OE for the 33 rd or 34 th Mailing - especially the 33 rd , I'd have throm me out for lack of pages. But no one was thrown out for the $33 r d$, and since no one was listed in the 33 rd as owing pages the next mailing, no one could be thrown out in the 34 th. I greatly approve of the $r$ eturn, in AA34, to listing people owing pages; herewith my contribution toward saving my mombership. I'm sure a number of people would be delighted if $I$ were to drop, and it is in keeping with my Imege that I rob them of that delight.

IESLEIGH COUCH did an excellent job with MIg. 34, considering the mess she was handed - and ever mareso, considering the fact that she was volunteered for the job by Woolston. I appluad, and suggest, Lesleigh, that you run for tho job when you do have the time to spare.
THE N'APA TREASURY is exactly where everyone thinks it is: in my pocket. It is going to stay there until the OE is electod for 1968. Thereally funny part of this bit, with various and sundry people complaining about the tre asury not boing turned over, is that absolutely no one has asked me for it. Mind you, I'm not sure they would have got it -- it would have depended on who asked and in what manner -- but that no one thought to bother asking indicates something of the level of intelligence of those complaining.

I am keeping the treasury until the announcement of a new OE election results, because as far as I am concerned, I was $x$ omoved from office illegally, and am under no obligation to surrender it until my term of office is aver.

The matter of whether I vas legally or illegally removed is now very moot. Until about April of this year, I was under tho admittedly mistaken impression that dues had been extended for all NFFF members as a result of a Directorate action. By the time I found out I was mistaken, I wasn't able immediately to send in dues. This was bet ween the March and June mailings, and by the end of May I had renewed my dues, and can prove it. So that when June'sdeadine came around, I was once more a legal and paid-up member of NFFF. But it wat toe late. A notice had gone out that all zines were to goto Woolston, and the mess degenerated from there. So be it. I am merely explaining, not arguing or looking for ei ther recriminations or further blithering about a sitm uation that is past discussion. Elect a new OE, and let's get on with the business of publishing N'APAzines. Oh, by the way, I am, of course,
munning for re-election. My dues are paid up through 1968!! (If elected, I'll probably renew for another year immediately, just in caso.) Remember, better that Bastard you know than the one you don't! I promisc to be just as exacting in throwing people out $f$ or not having their pages in as I used to bc, get the mailings out with the same speed as I used to, and do everything else I used to except let my dues lapse. (I'm an oddity in N'APA - all the other ex-OEs have quit and are not interested in even re-joining, let along muning for office again!)

THAT AMENDMENT that was up for vote in March failed, by the way, and would have done so even without certain machinations by some of the $103 \%$ types. Those who voted in favor of it did so with an eye to getting new members, whic $h$ they considered the APA needed badly. It appears it still needs new members, but without the amendment it is necessary for new member s of N'APA to pay not only the $\$ 1$ N'APA dues, but the (at le ast) \$1.75 NFFF dues (which appear to be going up, according to recent in-print discussions.) So be it. I see by the roster in MIg. 34 that N'APA has 25 members, 15 of whom owe 6 pp in this mailing. Good Luck!! At least one - Atkins - has said he is not continuing. So we have 24 out of a specified limit of 40 . Oh, well, IFFE APAs for the NFFFers, and all that... .

JUST TO GIVE YOU AN IDEA of the amount of turnover since this APA began, let's look at the list of those who joineu during the first 14 mailings: Of those who joined wi th the first mailing, ( 15 member s) only Woolston, Hayes, and I are still here -- and the other two have been dropped and rejoined (Woolston was out twice.) Of those who joined with Mailing 2, Meskys is still here, and Keymar. Alma Hill, dropp:-with MIg. 10, is a retread. The other 6 are gone. And of the 44 people who joined between Nailings 3 and 15 , NOT ONE is on our current ro ster! (I do not count danie Lamb, as she was listed as a non-contributing member, beginning with MIg. 8, so that, as NFFF Secretary-Treasurer, she would see the mlgs. She did not really join until very recently.)

The above information was obtained by comparing the Iist in G.M. Carr's GHMZINE from MIg. 16 with the current roster. GWi listed each member by the mailing with which he joined, and gave drop datos for those who had already left by MIg. 16. One of these days the list should be brought up to date, but that would mean finding all my mailings and ri ght now some of them are amon the unavailable.

In any casc, I think the point should be obvious. N'APA is barely eight years old--OK, $8 \frac{1}{2}$. That only 331 members haver cmained min th it for the last five years is some what appalling. SFPA can do better then that, and it has a 20 -member limit and has only been going for six years. As for SAPS and FAPA, the comparison is ludicrons. Part of the trouble, of cour se, is the 40 -member limit. Ther are always so many openings that members don't care aoout staying in, since thoy can always rejoin with no difficulty.

I think the new OE, whoever he is, should consider a revised set of Bylaws, including a lowered membership limit -- 30 at the most as a start to shaping up N'APA. If it continues to slide downhill at the present rate, it will somn not be Forth $\$ 3$ dues and 12 pages a year even from the completists.

You are, of course, quite at liberty to consider the above mere disgruntled grotching on my part; I am sure of this reaction from a few members, at least. But I, at'least, am still here to do the grotching. I wonder who will be here to listen to me in another year?
