The S A P S Index: Mailing XIII ~ Mailing XXXIV

This volume continues the listing begun by Walt Coslet in 1950, when he indexed the contents of the first twelve SAPS mailings.

This index describes the contents of each mailing by (1) order in the mailing; (2) cumulative order of all SAPSzines; (3) fanzine name, publisher, and date; (4) particulars of format and production.

(1) is almost self-explanatory; I need only add that items comprehended in another -- like poll-cards, ballots, fliers and so on -- are not counted separately.

(2) counts all magazines in SAPS mailings, beginning with the very first (Ron Maddox' AFTRIGANZA). Again, inclusions in other fanzines are not counted separately, but are designated with lowercase letters in alphabetical order. Magazines mailed separately, and therefore not legitimate SAPSzines*, are distinguished with capitals in alphabetical order attached to the number of the last magazine in the mailing, since they follow this without being part of the total.

(3) includes dates in the literal sense (months: Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sept Oct Nov Dec; Seasons: Spring Sum Aut Winter) together with other sorts of distinguishing designations given fanzines: V volume, N number, M mailing, and #cumulative number. Parentheses indicate that the date given is not indicated in the fanzine itself, but otherwise -- e.g. in the OO. And of course (nd) means no date. We should note here such curiosa as GMCarp's naming various issues of GEM TONES after minerals, and the supercumulative mix & numbering systems OpVoldesfan (Operation Voldesfan, Karen Anderson), OpCrifanac (Operation Crifanac, Dick Eney), and Owls (Coswalzine, Walt Coslet).

(4) particulars of format and production are given in the order: size, method of duplication, pagination. Sizes are given in inches or as S standard ($8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$), L legal ($8\frac{1}{2} \times 14$), 4to quarto (8×10), or pc US Government postcard ($3\frac{3}{16} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$). Methods of duplication usually are M mimeo, D ditto (or other spirit process), H hecto, O offset (or any kind of lithography), RS rubber stamp, P printing (i.e. letterpress), ph photography A airbrush and sk silkscreen. This is inadequate to deal with SAPS' resourcefullness in the matter of reproduction, naturally, so you'll find many "special" notes referring you to the footnotes. Pagination is given first as total sheets "a"; then number of

blank pages "b" -- remember that a sheet represents two pages, now -- or sometimes "x" for a page backed with another page from a different fanzine.

The SAPS Index, Mailings XIII ~ XXIV, is intended to encourage somebody to cover the next four years and thus bring us up to date. Whoever tries it has my good wishes and sympathy. This is Operation Crifanac CXIX, the fanzine which removes Walt Coslet's last excuse for existence and bores everybody else to tears.

Nan Gerdig was forced to drop faneb for a time and turned the club over to Coslet, who issued a program of such a rigorous nature that a blitz-krieg developed and Karen Anderson threw him out. A number of one-shots were published during this battle, particulars of which are wanted.

Coslet's OGship represents the change of editors calling for a change in the volume number of the Spectator. Thus Volume 11 is represented by this period, tho no mailings came out, and no issue of the Spectator was published, during Coslet's quasi-mixed-up-incumbency.
