PROGRAM: Author GARY ALAN RUSE shared his sometimes nightmarish experiences in the world of professional writing as he discussed "The Perils of Publishing . . . or How I Learned to Survive Rejection." Aspiring writers in the club were reassured by Gary's observation that a rejection slip does not spell the end of all hope for a particular manuscript; that patience and persistence in re-submitting rejocted manuscripts may result in their ultimate publication.

Gary encouraged aspiring writers to be open to suggestions from editors and noted that publishing decisions are sometimes based on factors other than the merits of the work in question. Because of this, patience, persistence, and faith in the quality of one's work are components as necessary to a writer's success as the ability to write well. Gary provided SFSFS members with much useful information with his writer's eye-view insights on the world of publishing and his talk was very well received. 
