In compiling this list Don Tuck has taken a quite different basis from that of the Australian Science Fiction Index, which is limited to Australian imprints of whatever origin.

The scope is all science fiction stories -- and commercially published relevant non-fiction -- written by Australians, wherever published. The majority of them have appeared in science fiction magazines abroad; some as books, both Australian and overseas; and some in Australian newspapers and general magazines and other miscellaneous media. None of these have been covered comprehensively before.

This is a valuable undertaking. It gives quite a different picture of Australian science fiction writing from what is generally assumed, putting on record much that is obscure and easily overlooked.
