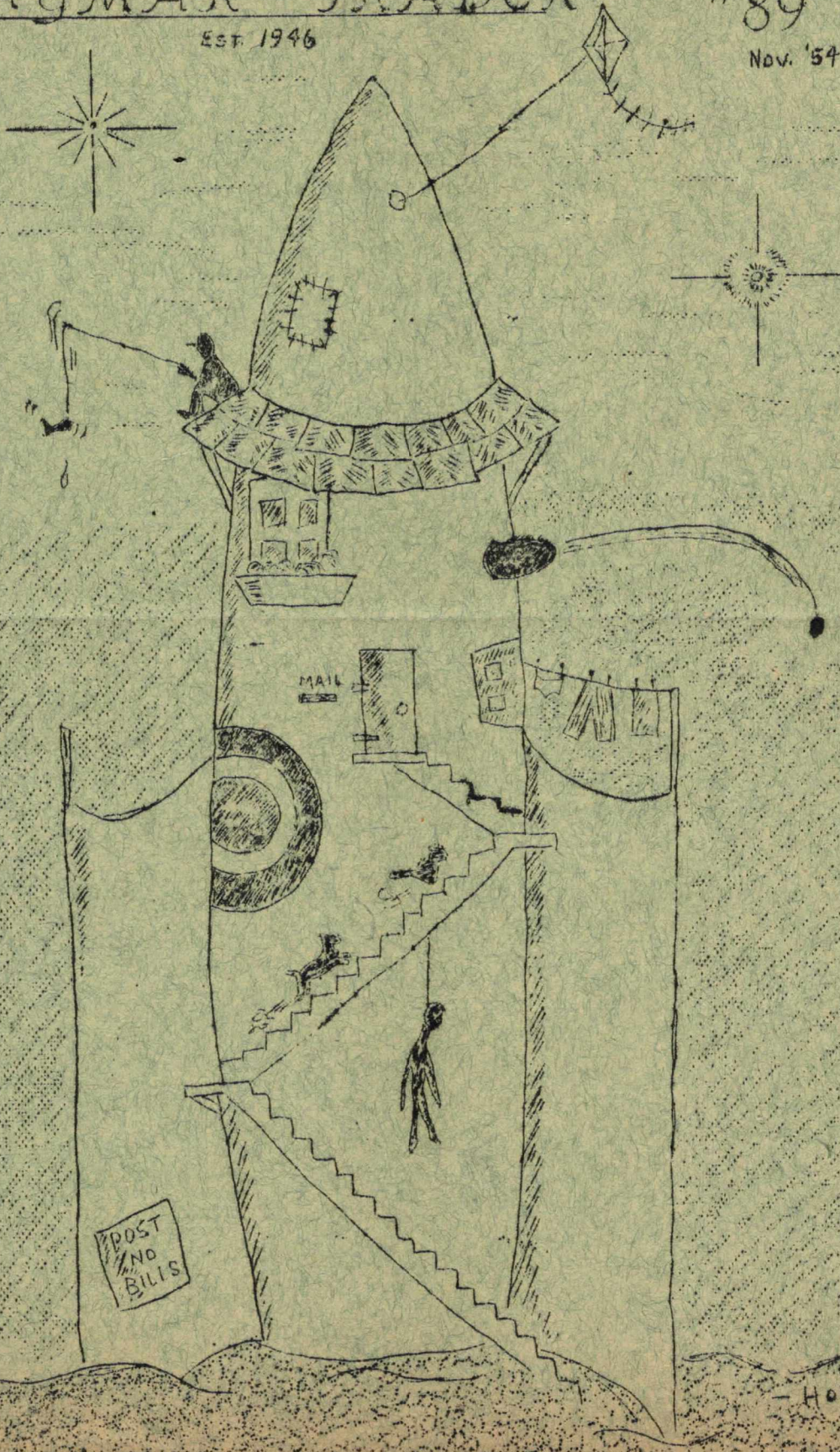

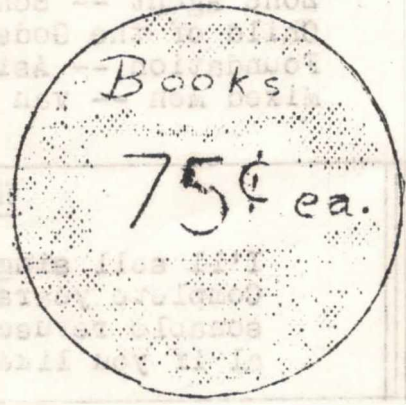

THE PRETTY WOMAN - Oliver. ALLSTORY Mar. 24. 1917.  
This is a different story. In fact, I think it is the 'differentest' story I ever read, and if any reader can make heads or tails of it, or determine what it is about and whether it is fantasy, I wish they'd tell me.

THE MAGIC MIRROR - Day. ALLSTORY Apr. 21, 1917.  
Scranton receives a mirror, with a note explaining it, in a parcel delivered by two Chinese. The note, he finds, is from his great uncle, who, at the time of writing, was about to be executed in a Tibetan monastery. It seems that the great-uncle had entrusted this to 2 friendly visitors to deliver, but the note ends before any explanation is forthcoming. Scranton opens the case containing the mirror and observes that his great-uncle's image is in it, but in attempting to open it, he trips and stabs himself accidentally. Next his wife finds it and throws a paper weight at it. Suddenly he awakens and realizes that he has been dreaming, and calls his wife and, rushing to the cabinet with her, opens it to see upon the screen a message explaining that it is incredibly old, made of a peculiar glass whose properties have not been explored and cannot be duplicated. They give it to the museum, as a memorial to the great-uncle. Good.

ABSOLUTE EVIL - Hawthorne. ALLSTORY Apr. 13, 1918.  
On a trip to Thirty Mile Beach, the protagonist, Martha Klemm, meets Nat Tyler, with whom she has a common ground of interest in witchcraft. Shortly thereafter, Martha returns to the beach to stay a while, there being no one else there at such a season except a little child and a woman. On a trip to the beach, Martha finds footprints leading from the surf to the woods, where they dance crazily about in a circle and then end abruptly. Later that day she meets a monstrous dog and shoots it, but misses: the next day she, bathing in the sea, hears a frightful scream and is horrified by the sight of the huge dog rushing away with something white in its mouth. She pursues the monster and wounds it, rescuing little Perdita, but the thing gets away. On her return to Boston, she finds Tyler dying, and learns from him that he is a werewolf.

THE WATERS OF OBLIVION - Mitchell. ELLERY QUEEN'S MYSTERY MAGAZINE Jan. 1944 (pardon the lateness of this choice, but I liked this one and thought that most fans did not know of it).  
Captain Hughes buys a little book on Pali at a bazaar, and, reading it, picks out the story of a man who, greatly saddened by the death of his brother, went to find a Well of Forgetfulness, finishing with the comment that he is going to apply the waters to his manuscript before he forgets his prior life altogether. And as he finishes reading, the Captain too loses his memory. I'll let you finish it.  
I won't bother reviewing THE GOD OF INVINCIBLY STRONG ARMS series that run in ALLSTORY in '14-'16, but will say that it is borderline fantasy at best and among the dumbest hack ever put on print.

THE REVELATIONS OF A MOORISH MIRROR - Cleveland. METAPHYSICAL MAGAZINE August 1896.

The hero meets one Mlle. Neferu Ahsoon, with whom he falls in love. He promptly gets drunk and, having gotten a soul-mirror, learns that he is the reincarnation of a pharaoh and she of his queen. Nyarlathotep preserve us from more like this!

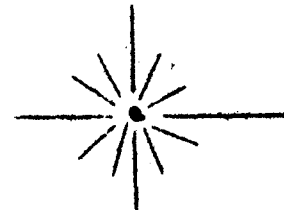
