

The Queens Science Fiction League has announced that they will resume publication of their official organ, under the editorship of Lee D. Quinn. Previously, the official organ was call, "Vadjong", but the publication will resume activity on January 15, under the new title of "New York's View".

It is announced by the Editor that the magazine will have a printed cover, but the rest of the publication will be mimeographed. The first issue of the magazine will be produced in limited edition and each copy will be individually numbered. This publication will be produced quarterly.

At this date the exact content of the magazine is not officially determined, but, the first issue will contain at least one major story by a very well-known professional author who resides in the metropolitan area.

The rest of the magazine's content is still in a plastic state, and will be constantly re-edited until the deadline on December first. 


