involved in 17 RiverCons and the 1979 NorthAmeriCon. I have been married to Steve Francis for 28 years, am the mother of five children, and the proud grandmother of ten with number 11 due before the end of the year. I enjoy attending conventions and meeting old friends and making new ones. I also enjoy partying. Just ask the folks at the 1992 DSC in Atlanta about my Mint Juleps.

I am asking for your help this year. You can help the Southern Fandom Confederation grow by showing your support with time, ideas and/or money. I would like to incorporate as many of your ideas into the SFC as possible.

The idea behind this is so a person moving or visiting in a new area can contact fans with the same interests. Should I include phone numbers in the listings? I am including addresses in this issue so that we can update our listings. Let me know if you want this practice to continue.

Thanks, Patrick, for remaining as vice-president and J.R. as secretary/treasurer. I will be calling on you for advice and help in the coming year.

The SFC is in need of a person or persons to promote Southern Fandom and to help in recruiting more SFC members. I hope to have three recruiters who go to Southern Cons and are willing to sit at a table during the convention to promote the SFC and to collect membership dues. SFC membership information

You can join the Southern Fandom Confederation by paying \$10.00 per year for an individual/family or \$50.00 for a club or convention. We will also accept donations in any amount. If for an example, you have a small club that cannot afford



to pay \$50.00, but would like to show support to the SFC, just send us whatever your club or group can afford. All such donations will be acknowledged in future *SFC Bulletins*. All fans whose memberships expired in 1991 or 1992 have had their memberships extended through the 1993 DSC because of the recent inactivity of the SFC.

DSC 31 will be held in Louisville, KY June 4-6 1993. Memberships are \$25.00 until May 16, 1993, and \$35.00 thereafter. (See ad elsewhere in this issue.)

DSC 32 will be held in Birmingham, AL, on the old traditional weekend. This is the weekend before the Worldcon. DSC 32 will be held on August 26-28, 1994. Memberships are \$20.00 thru DSC 31.

What's happening to the DSC?

The DSC's have been scattered throughout the calender in the past years. Membership at these conventions have been the same way. Years ago when the DSC was started, there were very few conventions in the South. The first DSC's were just fans getting together in homes, but as the DSC's grew they went to hotels to accommodate the larger numbers of fen that wanted to attend. The attendance has fluctuated in the last ten years from eight hundred fans to less than three hundred. Unfortunately, the attendance has been decreasing in the past few years.

What can be done to stop the decline of the DSC? Why are they shrinking? Are there too many Southern cons now to support a separate DSC? Should the DSC be combined with local or regional conventions? Should we (Southerners) pick a fixed date for the DSC, and have that as the only date groups could bid for?

I certainly do not have the answers. Westercon, which is the West Coast's traveling convention, is always on the weekend closest to the 4th of July holiday, either before or after. Would it help or hurt the DSC to have a specific date? Westercon's attendance averages between 2500 to 3500 people. It would be wonderful to see this happen to the DSC. Do any of you have suggestions as to what we can do to get increased support from Southern Fans for the DSC?

Southern Fans win Hugo

Congratulations, Dick and Nicki Lynch, for winning the coveted Best Fanzine Hugo award at Magicon, the 50th World Science Fiction Convention. Dick and Nicki are long time Southern fans who were active at Chattacons

for several years. They won the Rebel Award at the DSC 19 in Birmingham, AL. Good job, Dick and Nicki! We all know that the Hugo Award was long overdue. Again, congratulations and we hope to see you both at the next DSC.

Samanda Jeude's Big Heart

All of fandom has now recognized what Southern fans have known for years. Samanda Jeude was given the "Big Heart" award at Magicon. This award was given to Sam as a way for fandom to say "thank you" for all the years of dedication and service in making conventions aware of the needs of physically challenged fans. If any of you do not know Sam, you must meet her. She attended her first convention in 1975 (RiverCon), and countless others since. Sam has been active in costuming at local conventions as well as worldcons. (Yes, Sam, I still remember your Kelly Freas cover costume.) She has been a masquerade judge at many conventions and promotes Electrical Eggs wherever she goes. Congratulations, Sam, for a job well done!

SFC Business Meeting

The 1992 SFC business meeting was held Sunday, May 3 in Suwanee, Georgia, at DSC XXX.

The meeting was called to order at 10:15 a.m. by Patrick Molloy. There were no minutes available from the last meeting. The reading of the minutes was thus waived. P.L. Caruthers-Montgomery reported that her last bulletin was sent out in January, 1991. She had another bulletin scheduled to go out in June, 1991, but because of health reasons it was not finished.

P.L. also announced her retirement as President of the SFC because of her health and other responsibilities. All of her records are on disk, with nothing happening in the last year.

Ken Moore asked for a standing ovation for the work P.L. accomplished during her term as SFC president. Ken then nominated Sue Francis for president. Nominations were seconded and closed. Sue Francis was elected by acclamation.

For Vice-President, Ken nominated Steve Francis, who declined. He then nominated Patrick Molloy. The nomination was seconded and Pat was elected by acclamation.

Ken also nominated J.R. Madden for Secretary-Treasurer. The nomination was seconded and J.R. was also elected by acclamation.

The official SFC MCI phone card was passed over to the new president.

New Business:

Rich Gilliam reported that WorldCon Atlanta, Inc. had voted to pay for a GEnie account for the SFC president.

Guy Lillian urged all Southerners to join Magicon and vote for Atlanta. Rich Gilliam then urged the SFC to officially back the Worldcon Atlanta bid. Guy Lillian then made a motion for the SFC to officially endorse and support the WorldCon Atlanta bid. Patrick Molloy reminded everyone that the SFC has a policy to support Southern conventions so a vote was not necessary.

Suggestions:

Everyone would like to see the *Bulletins* published more frequently. Ken Moore has offered to print bulletins if they can be made camera-ready for him.

P.L. officially thanked Ken Moore for all of his support to her and the SFC.

Ken Moore suggested that conventions could send flyers for inclusion in the SFC Bulletin mail with a nominal fee to help defray postage.

Rich Gilliam reminded everyone that the WorldCon voting deadline was soon, and could we try to get a bulletin out before then. He also mentioned that bulk mail rates have been changed and that we should check on them.

It was decided to send the first bulletin out first class mail to correct defunct addresses and bulk mail thereafter.

Since there was no activity during the last year, perhaps we should extend the dues from last year to cover another year. Chattacon offered to make a donation.

Sue Francis is the fifth SFC President, therefore the first bulletin will be Vol.5, No.1.

Charlotte Proctor asked for a list of fans and clubs in the bulletin. On the clubs, it was suggested to list club name, where they meet, and the time. Also include the name and phone number of the contact person, their publications, interests, etc. It was also suggested that a file of all the old *SFC Bulletins* should be compiled. Steve Francis volunteered to do this. He should publish a list of what he has so everyone would know what is needed to complete the files.

The SFC needs at least one recruiter,

possible more. Julie Wall said maybe.

It was suggested that the SFC should promote itself more with flyers on freebie tables. Possibly regional conventions could donate a page in their program book for publicity.


It was moved to adjourn, seconded and passed with one nay vote by Guy Lillian.


