Louisville's Winter Storm '94

Steve and I decided to leave Chattacon (see con report on page two) at 1:00PM instead of 3:00 PM as planned, because of the predicted storm coming in from Memphis. We did not know what the forecasts were for Kentucky, but we wanted to get over Monteagle pass and on to Nashville before the roads got icy.


We were 10 miles from home when it started to rain. About three miles from home there was some freezing rain. We stopped at the local Kentucky Fried Chicken for take-out and started to hear and feel crunchy ice on the ground. We discussed stopping at the store for milk and bread (necessities in life). We passed right by the store, but didn't stop because there were too many cars in the parking lot. Oh well, we decided we'll just wait until tomorrow; little did we know what tomorrow would bring. Yes, we did listen to the radio on the way home but the forcasters were saying 1-3 inches of snow, maybe, NO BIG DEAL.

Louisville is not the snow capital of the world and 2-3 inches of snow can shut down the schools and city for one day, but you can get out to go shopping, etc. When I woke up I turned on the radio to see if we did get any snow as the weathermen predicted. The bad weather usually passes us by, but not this time.

The station announcer was talking about still being on the air because his relief hadn't been able to reach the station yet due to all of the of the ice and snow. Then they started to announce all of the school and business closings. State offices were closed, so I knew that I could go back to sleep because my daughter would not need me to watch her three little girls. Then the announcer said something about

everything is probably closed. Steve commented that his work would definitely not close. That was no more out of his mouth when they announced American Air Filter was closed.

Steve then got up and looked outside and told me to come have a look at what happened. We had a lot of snow on the ground and the snow was still coming down. We ended up with 18-1/2 inches of snow in the front yard and 20 inches in the back. I took a lot of pictures of the snow. After all, it had been 16 years since our last big storm.

The Commonwealth of Kentucky was shut down for five days, with the governor not allowing any travel on any of the interstates until Friday. Many people with four-wheel drive vehicles volunteered their time and took emergency personnel, doctors, and nurses to hospitals and took patients needing emergency medical treatment to hospitals as well. There was a little girl waiting for a liver transplant when the call came that one was available. The airports were shut down, but a helicopter could land in a church yard, but needed a landing area cleared. They put out calls for help and three large snow plows and about 150 people with snow shovels came to help clear the parking lot. People were great. The little girl was sucessfully given the liver transplant and has returned home to Louisville.

All in all it took seven days to clear the streets. And this was only the main streets, not the subdivisions. The city did a better job than the county or the state. We found out that Louisville has fewer snow plows than Atlanta. And they don't get snow as often as we do. Yes, I know that 18 inches of snow isn't much compared to what the Northern states get, but to us it was a *lot* of snow.

Steve closed the table at about 5:30, and we went to dinner at the Marriott with Larry Smith, and Jane and Scott Dennis. There were quite a few other fans there as well. The Read House restuarant has a limited menu so they could give faster service (last year there was usually a long wait). We had already eaten there Friday evening and did not want their limited menu again.

The biggest change that I noticed at Chattacon this year was their attempt to reduce the smoke in the Con Suite. In years past I was unable to breathe in the ConSuite, so I just did not go in. enjoyed visiting with a lot of friends and had a good time.


