MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

- When you overnight your zines, please remember to sign the little "no signature required" box. There isn't always someone home to sign for them.
- O Note that the "SE" in the OE's address is vital: there is a 165th Avenue Northeast in Bellevue, too, and confusion is worth two days at the post office.
- * Note that the OO doesn't get printed until Saturday afternoon of deadline weekend. The mailing doesn't go to the post office until Sunday afternoon or Monday morning. As long as your zine gets to me by Saturday's mail delivery you're guaranteed to make the mailing. In other words, no matter which Thursday is the statutory deadline, the effective deadline is the following Saturday.
- * As usual, I will put the table of contents from the mailing and contact information for me up on the **web**. See http://alumni.caltech.edu/~copeland/sfpa, for the time being until Steve Hughes and I can get our act together to take the show on the road. (And see the lengthy comment to Gary Brown in my zine this mailing about how we go about taking the show on the road.)
- * We're having the post-holiday blahs, and have a smaller mailing than September and November's monstrosities. I've no doubt we'll be back to full strength soon enough.
- The mailing once again is going out **Tuesday** morning rather than Monday morning because FedEx has managed to misplace Randy Cleary's zine, and mike weber's (which was supposed to be here on Saturday) is still not here.
- * Note that one of the entries early in this mailing is a **TAFF ballot**, provided by former SFPAn and TAFF candidate Curt Phillips. Note that the voting deadline is 10 February, so even if this reaches you by then, you'll need to vote quickly.
- This month's masthead is a fragment of a 1991 Soviet map of Badhdad, off the web at http://www.lib.utexas.edu/maps/index.html, the Perry Castañeda Library at the University of Texas. The Tigris River runs down the left side, with the Army Canal cutting diagonally across the S; Saddam City is under the TH. You'll notice that it even says "Baghdad" in Cyrillic.

We had a post-mailing last time, from mike weber, 1 page of "Crude Joke," which including the fractional OO brings mailing 231 to a page total count of 266.

THE RULES OF SFPA

- 1. The membership limit is 30; we will reinstitute a waiting list when we reach that point. Copy requirement is two more than the current roster count.
- 2. Minimum activity is 6 pages of original and personal writing and/or artwork in every two consecutive mailings.
- 3. Dues are \$15 per year. Dues are payable by the deadline of the mailing listed by each member's name. Failure to pay dues on time can result in the OE holding the mailing until dues are paid. An envelope addressed to the OE is included as a gentle reminder in the mailings of those owing dues, though it is not necessary to return your dues in that particular envelope. (Please be so kind as to make your dues check out to me, since our bank has stopped being cooperative about depositing checks made out to SFPA.)
- 3a. Dues may also be paid at a rate of \$43 per year to receive the mailings by Priority Mail. For those opting for Priority Mail delivery, dues may be paid in two installments, and your dues date will be extended three mailings. (Currently Dengrove, Larson, Lillian, Strickland, and Wells are receiving their mailings by priority mail.)
- 4. `Standing at the newspaper kiosk, deep in a copy of the *Continental Daily Mail*, stood a small, frog-like figure in glasses, and earnest, worried little man. He looked like a civil servant. Something like that.'
- 5. It costs \$5 to join the waiting list and an additional \$3 annually to remain on the list. Waiting listers must respond to the OO at least once every other mailing. Mailings are available to waiting listers and other interested parties for \$5 each on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- 6. Cohabiting couples can share a membership slot. Each member must meet minac and each has a vote. But they share one mailing and just one set of dues is required.
- 7. As expounded in SFPA's constitution, the contents of each zine are the responsibility of the contributor, not the Official Editor, who doesn't actually exercise any editorial control, but only acts as a distribution agent.
- 8. Always read *The Southerner* or you may not know what changes the OE is making, and you may find three dozen cruise missiles dropped down your chimney like Saddam Hussein.
