Various Business

* Starting on sad note, most of you have heard by now of the death of Irv Koch, long-time SF fan and former SFPA member. mike weber has sent along his obituary from the Atlanta Constitution-Journal. I met him only a time or two; so I look forward to reading memories of him from the rest of you next time.

* We've lost yet another member, though I hope this will be temporary. Steve and Suzanne Hughes have departed for Quito, Ecuador; planning to be there for six to twelve months. He sent me an email not long before they left in October hoping at that time to get something out before they left for good. I left him on the roster this time, I'll drop him next mailing unless I hear from him.

* A couple of members have made note that mailing #250 is coming up. That's a nice significant number and they thought we might like to mark it in some way; perhaps by contacting past members and asking them for a page or a note. I like the idea, but since I'm the new one here and don't know who used to be a member; I'll need someone else willing to contact former members or give me the contact info.

THE RULES OF SFPA

1. The membership limit is 30; we will reinstate a waiting list when we reach that point. Copy requirement is two more than the current roster count.

2. Minimum activity is 6 pages of original and personal writing and/or artwork in every two consecutive mailings.

3. Dues are \$15 per year. Dues are payable by the deadline of the mailing listed by each member's name. Failure to pay dues on time can result in the OE holding the mailing until dues are paid. I have kept Jeff's custom of an envelope addressed to the OE included as a gentle reminder in the mailings of those owing dues, though it is not necessary to return your dues in that particular envelope. Please be so kind as to make your dues check out to me, since I'm not sure I want to attempt to explain the concept of apas to my bank.

3a. Members who want to receive their mailings by Priority Mail should include enough extra to cover the difference between Media Mail and Priority Mail.

3b. Members who live outside the US will arrange with OE and willing members of SFPA as to how they will send their zines and receive their mailings.

4. Rule 4 has been dropped due to its inactivity. If it shapes up; it may be allowed to come back.

5. It costs \$5 to join the waiting list and an additional \$3 annually to remain on the list. Waiting listers must respond to the OO at least every other mailing. Mailings are available to waiting listers and other interested parties on a first-come, first-serve basis.

6. Cohabiting couples can share a membership slot. Each member must meet minac and each has a vote. But they share one mailing and just one set of dues is required.

7. As expounded in SFPA's constitution, the contents of each zine are the responsibility of the contributor, not the Official Editor, who doesn't actually exercise any editorial control, but only acts as a distribution agent.

8. Always read *The Southerner* or you may not know when deadline might fall or who has dropped off the roster.
