Now that the 1986 TAFF race has concluded my final duty, other than passing on all European TAFF monies and material to my successor, is to list the voting breakdowns and to announce a winner. Those standing this year were Simon Ounsley, Judith Hanna and Greg Pickersgill, listed by their initials in the tables below, with voters having the further options of writing in the candidate of their choice or of voting for funds to be held over - listed as HOF, or Hold Over Funds, in the tables below. While fans not resident in either Europe or North America can vote in TAFF races their ballots are not used in reckoning the 20% minimum of the votes cast on each side of the Atlantic that every candidate has to secure and have been listed separately. In this instance these were all from Australia and were collected by the US Administrators, Patrick and Teresa Nielsen Hayden. First place votes were as follows:

The write-ins were for Ken Slater, Terry Jeeves, and the Yorkshire Ripper in North America, and for Woofie Bear over here. No-one captured a majority of the votes cast so we needed to go to a second ballot, and since both Judith and the write-ins failed to poll 20% of the total vote on each side of the Atlantic theirs were the votes that were re-allocated according to the second place preferences listed on the ballots. Thus:
