



CALIFORNIA SEA OTTER

In California coastal waters, the California sea otter seeks large kelp beds, which provide both shelter and its favorite food, shellfish. By 1911, the California otter population was down to about 50 individuals. Under legal protection, years of steady growth brought the population up over 2,000, about 15 percent of the species' historic numbers. However, environmentalists are concerned by recent unexplained mortalities and a leveling of the population in the last few years. The potential for oil spills in the otter's coastal waters remains a great threat to its survival.

BALD EAGLE

In the lower 48 states. bald eagle numbers have soared from only 417 nesting pairs in 1963 to over 5.000 pairs in 1996. That year this magnificent bird's status was changed to the less imperiled category of threatened in the 45 states where it was previously listed as endangered. The comeback of the bald eagle is a tribute to both the banning of the pesticide DDT and recovery efforts under the Endangered Species Act, which has preserved key habitat for the birds and supported captive breeding and reintroductions.
