DEEP SPACE 9

2-HR PREMIERE: Same time-period as TNG. following the adventures of a team of Starfleet officers who take command of a remote alien space station on the edge of a new frontier. A century ago, Cardassians conquered the planet Bajor. After years of fighting Bajoran terrorists, Cardassians ravaged the planet & withdrew. Bajorans want Federation membership so Starfleet must aid the entry procedure, taking command of an abandoned Cardassian space station, Deep Space 9. It has a variety of humans & aliens who cannot be displaced & who are not happy with having Starfleet move in. DS9 is near the mouth of a newly discovered wormhole, which provides a shortcut to an unexplored quadrant. Travelers of all kinds are drawn here & with hostile alien enemies on all sides, DS9 becomes the most stra -tegic post in the galaxy.

<u>RUMOR-KILL</u>: DS9 was <u>never</u> meant to bridge the original series & TNG.

<u>DS9 UNIFORMS</u> reverse Starfleet: black & gray body with colored shoulders.

<u>RICK STERNBACH</u> designed the exterior of the space station, DS9.

DS9 AUDITIONS were held Aug 5 & 6, 300 people showed; 75 were cast, including Quark, Starfleet officers, Cardassians, Bajorans & hideous aliens. Among those auditioning were Clint Zehner, Daryl F. Mallett (who was in TNG & the prison scene in STVI), Cynthia Banning, Joni German, David Grow, & Angela Taylor. Auditions for the premiere movie beach scene were quite... pleasing!

STAR TREK: DEEP SPACE NINE CAST

AVERY BROCKS (DS9 Commander Benjamin Sisko) was "Hawk" to Robert Urich's "SPENCER: FOR HIRE". SISKO (not Cisco!) is a human widower raising a son after his wife was killed at Wolf 359 by the Borg, led by Locutus (Picard).

RENE ABERJONOIS (ODO, shape-shifter) was a regular on "BENSON." He was cut from ST VI as assassin Colonel West of Operation Retrieve, but is in the video version. ODO is the Security Officer, who knows only DS9 as home. His natural state is gelatinous but he grudgingly takes human form & takes other forms by "morphing" technology. A curmudgeon whose relationship with Quark is comic relief, he'll be a "mirror to humanity" that Spock, Data & Worf have been.

NANA VISITOR (Bajoran 1st Officer Major Kira Nerys) was on TV series "WORKING GIRL". <u>KIRA</u> is a former Bajoran terrorist who fought for independence all her life & does not believe the Federation should have been called in. Her own people force her into serving on DS9, but she loathes Cardassians.

TERRY FARRELL (Trill Science Officer Lt. Jadzia Dax) was in "HELLRAISER III", "BACK TO SCHOOL" & TV series, "PAPER DOLLS". DAX was originally a heavy-gravity alien in a gravitational wheelchair (too expensive) so became a Trill ("joined species" aliens seen in "THE HOST": interdependent entities exist in 1 body: a host & a symbiont an ancient invertebrate, androgynous life form). Sisko knew Dax when the Trill was inhabiting a male body; he has problems with Dax now being an attractive female.

COLM MEANY (Chief Operations Officer Miles Edward O'Brien) formerly served on the USS Enterprise. He is organized, efficient, smart, & knows the hardware. This assignment represents a promotion.

BASHIR (originally Amoros) Chief Medical Officer, new out of Starfleet, brilliant specialist in multi-species medicine; cocky, charming, naive young human with zealous expectations for the frontier where heroes are made.

CIRROC LOFTON (Jake Sisko, Cdr's son)
14-year-old African-American actor in
"BEETHOVEN"; DS9 is TV debut. JAKE is a
rebellious child with (unlike Wesley)
absolutely no technical skills; doesn't
remember Earth & feels his mom would be
alive if they did not live in space. He
pals with Quark's son, of course.

ROSALIND CHAO (Keiko O'Brien) goes with husband to DS9, but is not pleased to have little Molly Worf Ishikawa O'Brien on a run-down space station. She gives up botany to teach school on DS9. * Nov 13-15, CASTCON, Holiday Inn O'Hare, Chi

<u>CAMILLE SAVIOLA</u> (Kai Opaka, Bajoran spiritual leader), a Dalai Lama type who tries to heal her people.

MICHAEL MCRAE (Gul Dukat) & JOE SNETOW (Gul Jasad) are Cardassian bad guys.

FELICIA BELL (Sisko's wife), killed by Borgs, but seen in premiere flashback.



How long should we let this wasteful nonsense go on? America should have had Lunar & Mars bases years ago, with the first Martian-Americans already born! Instead, our Administration waffles, while Americans "wish upon a star" & watches the rest of the world become leaders in space. It is time to take action, to let Congress know how we feel about this! How?

- (2) Write/call your Congress-persons! They have a local office.
- (3) Copy & circulate the SPACE EXPLOR-ATION INITIATIVE petition as far & wide as you can. Drown Washington D.C. in petitions! Make them notice Space Advocates as they haven't noticed us since we named the first shuttle "Enterprise"!

Your comments come across to me as excuses ("reasons" for gay/lesbian invisibility) * If "THE OUTCAST" episode had related Soren's situation to Terran history of negative treatment of gays & lesbians..It could have been done in just one sentence!..this issue could have been put to rest. Shows as diverse as MURPHY BROWN, ROSEANNE & NORTHERN EXPOSURE have dealt with this issue... Can't ST writers do the same? David Gerrold wrote a TNG script, "Blood & Fire"..Gay invisibility is ended when Riker asks how long the gay characters have been a couple..a simple solution to something ST should be good at addressing, the diversity in Terran society...You say gays/lesbians are already shown on TNG going through daily routines like everyone else..Do they no longer date or celebrate relationship anniversaries? Why is it permissible for heterosexual crewmembers to do all these things?...If IDIC-based ST fans can't see how the invisibility of gays/ lesbians hurts society's development. then we really do have a lot of work still to do. You are respected & have influence, power..the only language the studios know. Supportive public words would go a long way toward positive acceptance. If people are silent, all society hears are hate-mongers..It is no longer enough for ST/ SF fans to be "tolerant"..in fanzines. ST fans have a role in the continuing civil rights -- Joseph (Jay) DeSort, Jr movement.

Would my "excuses" have read "right" to you were I lesbian? * From many viewpoints, the issue <u>WAS</u> addressed in "OUTCAST". * Where are TNG heterosexual monagamous relationships, except for

the O'Briens? * Michael Piller echoes GR: "Just showing 2 guys holding hands on the Enterprise would be a condescending nod.." * J. Michael Straczynski says of his show, "BABYLON 5": "There will not be a gay story - we'll just see gays & that's all." * David Gerrold told me that GR rejected his script for not being good TNG, NOT due to gay char -acters. * Jim Mees, TNG set decorator, said "As soon as you recognize only one group, you close out other groups." * Ernie Over (GR's assistant, now Majel Barrett-Roddenberry's) says "The only thing that will change the Communityat-Large is when attitudes change. 
